From the Desk of Fr. Sebastian,

Dear Friends,

One night, a man came home drunk. He ordered his wife, "I'm hungry. Give me something to eat!" The wife replied, "It's all there on the table. It's up to you to choose." Upon seeing what is on the table, the man complained: "What? With only one piece of dried fish, what choice do I have?" "Well," the wife said softly, "you can choose: to eat or not to eat."

Life consists of a series of choices. As human beings, we have the power and freedom to choose. Since we have the freedom to choose, the consequences of our selections are our responsibility. A person who chooses God is the wise person. This is because of three reasons: First, the Lord will wipe away our tears, fears and anxieties. Secondly, He will strengthen us to overcome obstacles of life. Finally, He will nourish us with his eternal banquet. This is in fact the summary of today's readings.

As illustrated in the Gospel story (Mt 22:1-4), God's invitation is open to all. It is for saints and sinners. It is for insiders and outsiders. However, as narrated in the Gospel, people did not use the opportunity for growing in grace. The invited guests made excuses. They did not show up. Worldly things consumed them. "God became one of the many choices." Unfortunately, they did not know what they were missing.

The Holy Eucharist is our heavenly banquet today. "Every time we receive him, he reminds us that we are precious, that we are guests he has invited to his banquet, friends with whom he wants to dine. And not only because he is generous, but because he is truly in love with us. He sees and loves the beauty and goodness that we are," (Pope Francis). Come to Jesus who is really, truly and substantially present in the Eucharist. Jesus is inviting us every Sunday to the Eucharistic Table to encounter him, consume him and become his Eucharistic presence in the world.

DID YOU KNOW?

Protecting Vulnerable Adults

While a primary focus of those in ministry is on protecting children from harm, protecting vulnerable adults is just as important. This includes adults living with mental, emotional, or physical disabilities, adults who have court-appointed guardians, elderly adults in vulnerable positions, and anyone else who may be unable to consent to or understand what is happening to them. Every year, nearly 500,000 reports of abuse against vulnerable adults are made to the Adult Protection Service, and even more go undetected. The same steps and processes outlined for protecting children can help vulnerable adults as well — know the warning signs, screen all employees and caregivers, and monitor environments for safe practices. 


