From the Desk of Fr. Sebastian,

Dear Friends,

There was a blind boy. He sat on the corner of a road with a signboard: "I am blind. Please help me." Not many people paid attention to the boy. He got only a few coins. A monk came that way. He gave him some money. But he did something different also. He changed the words on the signboard like this. "Today is a beautiful day, Thank God. I can see it."

Things changed dramatically. A lot more people started noticing that boy and trying to help him. What made the difference? The first sign simply told them that he is blind. The second sign made the people aware that they were not blind.

This Thursday is Thanksgiving Day. Gratitude is intrinsically related to our Christian spirituality. We call ourselves a 'Eucharistic People.' "Eucharist" is a Greek word, which means "thanksgiving." So, we are 'Thanksgiving People.'

Gratitude is ultimately an expression of humility. It affirms our dependence on God. It is an expression of our acknowledgement that everything is a blessing. God has bestowed us with many gifts and talents according to our abilities. Some may have one talent and someone else may have three or five talents. Compliment it. Compliments bring happiness and complaints bring misery. "Some people grumble that roses have thorns; I am grateful that thorns have roses," says Alphonse Karr.

Often, we are not aware of our own blessings. A man was complaining about his shoes until he noticed a person without a leg. Let us open our eyes and see our blessings. Let us count our blessings today. The more we think about our blessings the happier we will be. Acknowledging the good that we already have in our life is the foundation of all abundance.

I am grateful to our St. Francis Xavier Community. This community is beautiful and joyful because of each one of you. Your generosity with your time, talents and treasure is the salt of this community. Let us celebrate it with a grateful heart.

Next Sunday is the Feast of the Christ the King. We will have the anointing of the hands at all masses. This symbolizes our commissioning to work for the Kingdom of God.




