## From the Desk of Fr. Sebastian,

Dear Friends,

We are at the end of the Liturgical year. On this final Sunday, we celebrate the Feast of Christ the King. This Feast was instituted in 1925 by Pope Pius XI in an encyclical titled "Quas Primas" and was Pius' response to the increasing secularization and nationalism in the aftermath of World War I. The feast is intended to proclaim in a striking and effective manner Christ's royalty over individuals, families, society, governments, and nations.

As we all know, there is a spiritual illness (Spiritual Alzheimer) slowly crawling across the world. Moreover, great forces are actively working at present to undermine the reality of spirituality. What is the truth? The truth is that in the absence of Jesus who is the light, the whole world will be in darkness. If we ignore Jesus who is the way to true life, then we will wander in the world cluelessly.

As disciples of Jesus, it is our duty to be counter cultural. In other words, we are called to proclaim the supremacy of God and the futility of secularization. If we don't do it, then who will do it? The story of Padre Miguel Pro is inspiring. During the religious persecution in Mexico, this young Jesuit priest did not plead for his life, instead he kissed the crucifix and stood up shouting, "Viva Cristo Rey." It means 'long live Christ the King.' Thomas More on his way to his execution said to King Hendry, "I am the Kings good servant, but God's first."

Representing Jesus Christ in our time is our baptismal call. The sacrament of Baptism anoints and commissions us to be a king, prophet, and priest. To remind us of this noble call, this Sunday at all masses we anoint the hands of everyone.

Next Sunday, we begin a new Liturgical year with the Holy Season of Advent. Advent is the sacred time when we prepare for the incarnation of Christ the King. As we did last year, this year too we will have the "Christmas Tree Lighting Ceremony." A Christmas tree will be eructed in the breezeway. Children are invited to bring ornaments on the First Sunday of Advent to decorate the Tree. This will continue the second Sunday of Advent as well. On the second Sunday, after 5 pm Mass, we will light the tree. Decorating the Christmas Tree is a symbolic gesture of preparing our heart for Jesus. Let us make every opportunity a moment of grace.

On the First Sunday of Advent (December 3), that is the Feast Day of St. Francis Xavier our patron saint too, our Native American Community is having a special celebration at the 10 am Mass. Let us welcome them by attending the celebration.

## How do groomers work?

Groomers start by picking out a potential victim, often a child who is emotionally vulnerable or isolated, or with low self-esteem. Then, groomers will start to slowly build a relationship — bonding over an alleged shared interest and expanding relationships out to build trust with the victim's family and friends. Groomers work hard to make themselves appear trustworthy and safe, to gain better access to their victims. From there, they can isolate their victims and perpetrate abuse. 


