From the Desk of Fr. Sebastian,

Dear friends,

The mystery of human existence lies not in just staying alive, but in finding something worthwhile to live for. If a man has not discovered something that he will die for, he is not fit to live (MLK). More men fail through lack of purpose than lack of talents.

"What are you looking for?" Jesus asked Andrew and his friends who followed him. This is the most important question all of us need to ask. "What am I looking for? What is the purpose of my life? What is that drives me when I wake up in the morning? When I go to work, or when I go to school."

Let us all recognize that God has a purpose for our lives. "Many are plans in a person's heart, but it is Lord's purpose that prevails" (Proverbs 19:21). To understand His plan, one has to go to Him. So Jesus said to them, "Come and see where I am living."

St. Francis Xavier School is currently accepting names to be placed on our waiting list of students interested in entering Transitional Kindergarten through Eighth Grade in August 2024. All families who wish to have their children considered for Fall entrance are asked to contact the school office between the hours of 8:30 A.M. and 4:00 P.M., Monday through Friday. This includes families who have children currently enrolled at St. Francis Xavier School and would like younger or older siblings considered for admission.

In regard to Transitional Kindergarten and Kindergarten Applicants:
Due to the difference between ability and maturity levels and the corresponding relationship to school readiness, Kindergarten applicants must turn 5 years old by November 1st to be eligible to take the entrance screening.

Transitional Kindergarten applicants must turn 4 years old by November 1st to be eligible for the entrance screening.

DID YOU KNOW?

How to Actively Listen to Abuse Disclosures

Disclosing abuse is one of the hardest — and most important — steps for a victim to take. If a child chooses to tell you about abuse, make sure you are actively listening. Give the child all of your attention and listen calmly, without making judgements or assumptions. Listen patiently without filling in the blanks or making suggestions. The best thing is for the child to tell his or her own story. Ask limited questions, and only for information needed to report abuse.
