From the Desk of Fr. Sebastian,

Dear Friends,

There is this interesting tale, a Teenager decided to follow Jesus. He got a piece of paper and made a list of great things that he was planning to do for God, and then placed it on the altar. However, he did not feel anything. His feeling was sheer emptiness. He made a longer list of doable things and put it on the altar; but still he felt nothing. He went to his pastor for help. The pastor said, "Take a blank sheet of paper, sign your name at the bottom of it and place it on the altar." The young man did as suggested by the pastor, and then peace came to his heart.

Christianity is not about doing something for Christ. It is not about a doctrine or an idea. It is not about a set of rules and regulations. It is all about a person. It is all about the person of Jesus. For example, when Jesus called his disciples he did not offer them something nor did he promise them anything. He told them: "Follow me."

Following Jesus means humbly submitting our entire self to Him through the process of repentance. Repentance is more than turning away from sin. It is awakening the presence of Jesus in us. It is rediscovering God's image in me. It is clearing my heart for Him.

To follow Jesus and experience repentance the first condition is to know Jesus more intimately through meditative prayer. Meditate on Jesus until you can see through the eyes of Jesus. Remember Paul's words: It is not me but Jesus lives in me. Living in Jesus and with Jesus is the most joyful experience.

Transitional Kindergarten applicants must turn 4 years old by November 1st to be eligible for the entrance screening.
