From the Desk of Fr. Sebastian,

Dear Friends,

Every first Sunday of Lent, we reflect on the temptation story of Jesus in the desert. This narrative elucidates three crucial aspects. Firstly, it underscores the reality of temptations. If Jesus, the Son of God, faced temptations, how much more susceptible are we? Secondly, temptations unveil our inner desires, our driving forces. Thirdly, they equip us with the tools to combat and conquer temptations.

Jesus encountered his temptations in solitude. One prevalent tactic the Devil employs today is busyness. Consequently, we lack the time for introspection. By the time we discern our trajectory, it may be too late to effect change.

The Devil is cunning. His tactics was to confuse Jesus of his identity. The Tempter challenged Jesus: "If you are the Son of God, turn these stones into bread." Essentially, the Tempter questioned Jesus' certainty about his identity and demanded proof. Jesus did not yield to this temptation. Many of us today grapple with the temptation to assert our independence—our independence from God and from one another.

To help us turn more intensely to Jesus, we have scheduled several spiritually uplifting programs. Please participate in them and grow in your relationship with Jesus. This Sunday, the first Sunday of Lent, each family will receive a lighted purple candle along with a Lenten prayer. This candle serves as a reminder of our identity: 'We are a chosen people and God's special possession. We are chosen and called out of darkness into his wonderful light.' (1 Peter 2:9). Please light the candle every evening and recite the Lenten prayer. Let us walk in the light of Jesus.

Additionally, don't miss Sunday Mass during Lent. If possible, try to attend daily Mass as well. Please join us for the Stations of the Cross, Soup Supper, Lenten Reflections (on Wednesday evenings starting at 5:30 pm), and Holy Hour on Fridays at 6 pm. During the Holy Hour on Fridays, a priest will be available to hear confessions. Engaging in these spiritual practices will help us live our lives more fully.

We had a beautiful and highly successful retreat. Thank you for attending. I am grateful to Deacon Jaime for coordinating the retreat, efficiently and effectively. I am also extremely appreciative of Richard Dixon for sponsoring the retreat. Thank you.

Let us make an earnest effort to make this season of Lent a time of spiritual renewal for our community and for each one of us personally.

This five week process emphasizes the basics of Catholic teaching. The last session is reconciliation (confession) with a priest in Church.


Sessions are weekly, Thursday evenings at 6:30 in the Library (across from the front entrance to the church).

DID YOU KNOW?

Why does it help to communicate your concerns?

If you have concerns about someone's behavior, sharing those concerns is critical to protecting the children in that person's life. If you see or hear about inappropriate behavior, you can take your concerns to a supervisor or program director for further action. This helps those in charge launch an investigation, ask questions, and start to look for signs on their own — all of which can help keep children safe from potential abuse. Communicating your concerns, and having them investigated, can also discourage a potential offender, pushing them to leave the program or stop their behaviors.
