

From the Desk of Fr. Sebastian,

Dear Friends,

The Gospel reading for the second Sunday of Lent is the Transfiguration of Jesus. Through the Transfiguration Event Jesus showed three of his disciples a glimpse of heavenly life. Heaven is real. Our ultimate goal is to get to heaven. The question is how we get there.

When the disciples had the heavenly vision, with all excitement Peter said, "Master, it is good that we are here; let us make three tents, one for you, one for Moses, and one for Elijah." However, God did not approve his proposal. Instead, God said: Listen to Jesus. Salvation is not a free gift. We need to do our part.

Making a plan for ourselves independent of God will disfigure us. Adam and Eve set aside God's plan and listened to the Serpent. The people of Babel set out to make a name for themselves. The result was tragedy.

Renewal happens when we begin to listen to Jesus and surrender our plan to His plan. Abraham is a great example of active listening. Their obedience to God's plan did not go in vain. God blessed them abundantly. Abraham became the Father of faith when he gave up his plan and accepted God's plan. Mary became the Mother of God, when she gave up her plan and accepted God's plan. Paul became the great evangelizer when he gave up his plan and accepted God's plan...! Listen to God, discern his plan and live it faithfully. As we read in the book of Romans (Roman 8:31), "If God is with us who can stand against us?"

Lent offers us a chance to remember what matters, to strip away what is unimportant, and to reclaim our identity. We may not necessarily get a Mountain Top experience like Peter, James and John had. However, Jesus is coming to us today through different spiritually uplifting programs. He is speaking to us through the Eucharistic celebration, through the Sacrament of reconciliation, through Lenten reflections, through Holy Hour, and so forth.

Do not miss opportunities of grace. Tune into Jesus and say: Here I am Lord; I come to do your will.



Entrance to St. Francis Xavier School

Come and explore the academics, special subjects, extracurricular activities, and enrichment at St. Francis Xavier School. School tours are available by request. Please call the school office at (818) 504-4422 for an appointment.

St. Francis Xavier School is currently accepting names to be placed on our waiting list of students interested in entering Transitional Kindergarten through Eighth Grade in August 2024. All families who wish to have their children considered for Fall entrance are asked to contact the school office between the hours of 8:30 A.M. and 4:00 P.M., Monday through Friday. This includes families who have children currently enrolled at St. Francis Xavier School and would like younger or older siblings considered for admission.

In regard to Transitional Kindergarten and Kindergarten Applicants: Due to the difference between ability and maturity levels and the corresponding relationship to school readiness, Kindergarten applicants must turn 5 years old by November 1st to be eligible to take the entrance screening. Transitional Kindergarten applicants must turn 4 years old by November 1st to be eligible for the entrance screening.

Understanding "sexting"

"Sexting" is the sending of sexually explicit messages or images via text. Sexting commonly happens in conversations between teens and tweens, and usually involves nude "selfies." When these images are shared or distributed on social media platforms like TikTok, Instagram, and Snapchat, the problem is made worse. Some states have laws against sexting that could have criminal ramifications for teens. 
