From the Desk of Fr. Sebastian,

Dear Parish Community,

This Wednesday, we begin the sacred season of Lent. It is a time when God calls us by name, saying: "Return to me with all your heart." (Joel 2:12). Lent is not just about giving up certain things; it is about growing closer to God. It is a time to look into our hearts and ask: Where am I in my relationship with God? Have I been drawing closer to Him, or have the worries, distractions, and temptations of life pulled me away?

The beautiful truth is that God never stops waiting for us. He is always ready to embrace us with mercy. Traditionally, the Church gives us three spiritual tools to help us return to God: prayer, fasting, and almsgiving.

As a community, we are called to deepen our prayer life. We can do this by attending daily Mass when possible, praying the Rosary together, or simply sitting in silence with God for a few extra minutes each day.

Fasting is about making room for Christ. It means detaching from whatever takes priority over God in our lives. We can fast from impatience, anger, or distractions. Imagine how our families, friendships, and community would be transformed if we fasted from negativity and instead chose love, kindness, and understanding.

The purpose of almsgiving is to share God's love with others. During this Lent, let us seek ways to serve—whether through acts of charity, kindness, or reaching out to someone who is struggling.

Lent is a season of hope. It is a time when we prepare not just for the Cross but also for the Resurrection. The struggles we face, the sacrifices we make, and the prayers we offer are all leading us to new life in Christ.

Do not wait for the perfect moment to change—the time is now. As a community, let us walk this Lenten journey together. We have planned several uplifting programs during Lent. Please see the inside pages of the bulletin for details.

I also take this opportunity to thank everyone involved—Rita Recker, Rene Decena, Anna Jackson, Chris Hardin, Jack Clapper and Cornerstone—for making our celebration of Saints of St. Francis Xavier so beautiful. I am also grateful to Richard Dixon for his assistance last Sunday in promoting the Together in Mission campaign.

The Hospitality Room has been completed! The countertops have been installed as well as the sink faucet and a few last minute electrical items. The faucet is gold to match the knobs and handles in the room. The stainless steel sink is extra large to accommodate coffee pots. The refrigerator has returned to its new

location. Everything looks very pristine.

The Science Lab also had countertops installed. The plumber also added four faucets to our eight-foot sink and a dishwasher. The existing sound boards are being re-installed on the ceiling. I am learning about acoustics. I didn't know that to be effective, sound boards shouldn't be more than 23" apart. Ideally they should be 1.5-2.0" thick. We are going to start in the center of the room and work our way out with the ones we have. We are going to wait for the rest of the furniture to be ordered and installed before we buy more.
