# From the Desk of Fr. Sebastian,

Dear Parishioners,

Today, May 4, during the 5:00 PM Mass, 31 young people from our St. Francis Xavier Community will receive the Sacrament of Confirmation from His Excellency, the Most Reverend Albert Bahhuth, our regional bishop. Let us keep them in our prayers, asking God to guide them as they discern His will and take their place in the life of the Church, participating in ministries according to their unique callings. We are deeply grateful to Bishop Bahhuth for his love, care, and support of our SFX Community.

Also this month, the conclave for electing our new Pope will begin in the Vatican. Let us unite in prayer, asking the Holy Spirit to give us a Shepherd after the heart of Jesus.

Today's Gospel is both challenging and encouraging. We hear Jesus ask Peter three times, "Peter, do you love me?" In Greek, there are different words for love. Agape means unconditional love — a love willing to sacrifice everything. Phileo refers to a love of friendship and affection. The first two times, Jesus asked Peter, "Do you Agape me?" And Peter responded, "I Phileo you." The third time, Jesus met Peter where he was and asked, "Peter, do you Phileo me?"

This moment reveals the gentleness and greatness of Jesus. He does not demand more than we are able to give. Instead, He invites us to offer what we can with humble hearts — and then He does the rest. Jesus sees in us what others do not, even what we cannot see in ourselves. Here's the Good News: Jesus saw in Peter endless possibilities. He gave him a new name — Rock — and a new mission.

Today, we are excited to launch a new ministry for Young Adults and Families called "Come to Me." Our first gathering — our "Come and See" event — is this Wednesday, May 7, at 6:00 PM. Please join us! Enjoy dinner, fellowship, and learn more about this beautiful new opportunity. It's part of our Jubilee celebration!

Yesterday (Saturday), 32 of our children received their First Holy Communion — what a joyful day for our young saints! Congratulations to them, and heartfelt thanks to Rosie, Mrs. Terry, and their wonderful team for preparing them so well. Thank you also, dear parents, for giving your children the greatest gift — Jesus Himself in the Eucharist. Children, now that you have received First Communion, you are invited to serve as Altar Servers, the first ministry in the Church! Herman, our Director of Altar Servers, will be reaching out to you.

The Month of May is dedicated to our Blessed Mother Mary. May Crowning is a beautiful tradition of honoring her. I encourage you to crown the image of Mary in your homes and to pray the Rosary daily as a family. I promise you: blessings upon blessings will flow from it!

St. Francis Xavier School is currently accepting students entering Transitional Kindergarten through Eighth Grade in August 2024. All families who wish to have their children considered for Fall entrance are asked to contact the school office between the hours of 8:30 A.M. and 4:00 P.M., Monday through Friday.

In regard to Transitional Kindergarten and Kindergarten Applicants: Due to the difference between ability and maturity levels and the corresponding relationship to school readiness, Kindergarten applicants must turn 5 years old by November 1st to be eligible to take the entrance screening. Transitional Kindergarten applicants must turn 4 years old by November 1st to be eligible for the entrance screening.

# DID YOU KNOW?

#### Safe Adults Can Have A Generational Effect

A child who is a victim of sexual abuse does not just suffer in the moment of the abuse, but in the short and long term afterwards. Abuse has far-reaching consequences, and studies have shown that children of parents who were abused as children, and even grandchildren, are more likely to also experience abuse. Safe adults can break this cycle, by being aware of potentially dangerous situations and by providing a safe space and listening ear for the children in their care. 
