From the Desk of Fr. Sebastian,

Dear Parish Family,

The gospel reading is a scene from the Last supper. The atmosphere is heavy. Judas had just left to betray Jesus. Jesus turned to his disciples and said something deeply beautiful: "I give you a new commandment: love one another. Just as I have loved you, you also should love one another."

Jesus does not say, "Be successful," "Be impressive," or "Be right." He says, "Love." And not just any kind of love—but a love that mirrors his own: self-giving, sacrificial, and unconditional. A love that washes feet. A love that endures betrayal. A love that lays down life. Jesus' life redefines love: not as a feeling or a philosophy, but as an action rooted in humility and service.

The true mark of a Christian is not how much we know or how perfectly we follow rules. It's how well we love. That means in our families, our parishes, our communities, even in our disagreements—we are called to show a love that reflects Jesus. Jesus is clear: "By this everyone will know that you are my disciples, if you have love for one another."

As we continue through this Easter season, let us allow the risen Christ to transform our hearts. Let us love not just when it's easy, but especially when it's hard. Let us forgive. Let us serve. Let us listen. Let us be patient. Because in the end, what will matter most is not how loudly we spoke, or how much we achieved—but how deeply we loved.

We will celebrate Mass in the parking lot this Sunday at 10:30 am as part of our Jubilee Celebration. After Mass, there will be BBQ and games for kids. Join us in this joyful expression of community!

We will honor our Blessed Mother with a May Crowning, Next Sunday at the 10:00 AM Mass. Children who received First Holy Communion and our Confirmands will lead the Rosary Procession to the grotto and the crowning ceremony. Please join us for this beautiful tradition.

Let us keep Pope Leo XIV in our prayers as he begins his new role as the Shepherd of the Church. We are proud that he is our fellow citizen—what a privilege and blessing! Let us offer him our congratulations through our prayers.

Let us keep in our prayers the students who will be graduating on May 29. May they reflect their Christian identity wherever they go for their future studies. Let us also pray for our parish, its ministries, and school. May the Holy Spirit, who transformed the disciples on Pentecost, keep us close to Jesus and to one another.

PRAY FOR THE SICK

Age-appropriate Curiosity in Young Children

Knowing the difference between age-appropriate and inappropriate behaviors in children can help safe adults determine whether something feels "off" about a child's behavior and could indicate potential sexual abuse. For preschool children and young children (around ages 4-6), exploring their bodies is natural. They are not yet old enough to understand the idea of "private" naturally, and may also be curious about others' bodies – parents, friends, etc. These behaviors are common and developmentally appropriate for their age and stage. 


