From the Desk of Fr. Sebastian,

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Today we celebrate the beautiful feast of Corpus Christi—the Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ. While every celebration of the Eucharist is a profound encounter with Jesus, the Church gives us two special days to pause and reflect more deeply on this sacred mystery: Holy Thursday and Corpus Christi. On Holy Thursday, our hearts are drawn to the love and sacrifice of Jesus as He institutes the Eucharist. Today, on Corpus Christi, we fix our gaze on His Real Presence in the Eucharist.

Let us remember: Jesus Christ is truly present in the Holy Eucharist—not as a mere symbol or memory, but fully, substantially, and personally. Why do we believe this? Because He told us so. At every Mass, when the priest speaks those sacred words, "This is My Body... This is My Blood," something miraculous happens. Though the bread and wine appear unchanged, their very essence becomes Jesus Himself. This is the fulfillment of His promise: "I am with you always, even to the end of the age."

Every altar becomes Calvary. Every Mass is a miracle of love. The Eucharist is Jesus—Body, Blood, Soul, and Divinity—offered for you and for me. It is not a ritual to attend, but a Person to worship. That's why today, after the 10:00 AM Mass, we will have a Eucharistic Procession. Let's proclaim together, in word and witness, what our hearts believe: "Lord, to whom shall we go? You have the words of eternal life. You are the Bread of Life."

The Eucharist is not just something we receive—it is Someone who changes us. The word "Mass" comes from missa—"sent." We are sent from every Eucharist to be His presence in the world. In our homes, workplaces, and communities, we are called to be His hands, His feet, His heart—broken and shared for others.

So let us approach this mystery not out of habit, but with awe and gratitude. May we teach our children to love the Eucharist. May we renew in ourselves a deep reverence for this treasure beyond all price. And may we always remember: Jesus is with us—truly, really, and always—in the Most Holy Eucharist.

St. Francis Xavier School is currently accepting students entering Transitional Kindergarten through Eighth Grade in August 2025. All families who wish to have their children considered for Fall entrance are asked to contact the school office between the hours of 8:30 A.M. and 4:00 P.M., Monday through Friday.

In regard to Transitional Kindergarten and Kindergarten Applicants: Due to the difference between ability and maturity levels and the corresponding relationship to school readiness, Kindergarten applicants must turn 5 years old by November 1st to be eligible to take the entrance screening. Transitional Kindergarten applicants must turn 4 years old by November 1st to be eligible for the entrance screening.
