From the Desk of Fr. Sebastian,

Dear friends,

Today, we celebrate the Solemnity of Saints Peter and Paul—two great pillars of the early Church. Though vastly different in personality and mission, they were united in their love for Christ, their zeal for the Gospel, and their willingness to lay down their lives for the faith.

Peter, a humble fisherman, was often impetuous. He spoke quickly, acted impulsively, and even denied Jesus three times. Yet, after each fall, he returned with a repentant heart. Jesus embraced him and made him the 'rock' of the Church. His life teaches us that the Christian journey is not about perfection, but perseverance. Peter reminds us that "God does not choose the qualified; He qualifies the chosen."

Paul's story is equally powerful. Once a fierce persecutor of Christians, he encountered the risen Lord on the road to Damascus, and that encounter changed his life forever. From then on, Paul could say with boldness, "It is no longer I who live, but Christ who lives in me" (Galatians 2:20). He became the Church's greatest missionary. Paul reminds us that no past is too broken for God to heal, and no life is beyond the reach of divine grace.

Though Peter and Paul were different—Peter representing the pastoral heart of the Church, and Paul its missionary fire—they were both necessary. The Church needs both: the stability of Peter and the outreach of Paul; the centripetal force that gathers the faithful and the centrifugal force that sends us out on mission.

Today, the Church still longs for hearts like theirs—courageous, repentant, and set on fire by love for Christ. As St. Paul wrote: "Woe to me if I do not preach the Gospel!" (1 Corinthians 9:16). And as Peter exhorted: "Always be ready to give an explanation to anyone who asks you for a reason for your hope" (1 Peter 3:15).


Before concluding this reflection, I want to express my heartfelt gratitude to each of you who took part in our Eucharistic Procession. It was a powerful and moving testimony of our faith in the Real Presence of Jesus in the Eucharist. May this faith not remain only in words or rituals, but truly transform our lives—so that, like Saints Peter and Paul, we may become living witnesses of Christ in our world today.

This Friday is 4th of July. I wish you a joyful Independence Day filled with gratitude, peace, and celebration. As we remember the sacrifices made for our freedom, may we also renew our commitment to unity, justice, and hope for all. May God bless America and guide us to be a nation that always seeks truth, peace, and the common good.

All families who wish to have their children considered for Fall entrance are asked to contact the school office between the hours of 8:30 A.M. and 4:00 P.M., Monday through Friday.

In regard to Transitional Kindergarten and Kindergarten Applicants: Due to the difference between ability and maturity levels and the corresponding relationship to school readiness, Kindergarten applicants must turn 5 years old by November 1st. Transitional Kindergarten applicants must turn 4 years old by November 1st.
