

From the Desk of Fr. Sebastian,

Dear Parish Family,

Today's Gospel presents the beautiful and familiar story of Martha and Mary. When Jesus visited their home, the two sisters responded to Him in different ways. Jesus affirms Mary's choice over Martha's. Why? What did Mary do right, and what did Martha do wrong?

Mary responded to Jesus the way He desired, while Martha responded in the way she thought was best. Jesus likely arrived at their home tired after a long day of preaching and teaching, perhaps even misunderstood and mistreated by many. He was not looking for food, but for a listening and understanding heart. Mary recognized this and offered Him exactly what He was longing for.

A gift is only truly a gift when it meets the heart of the one receiving it. This truth applies to all our relationships. Do we take the time to understand others? Or do we treat them only in the way we prefer?

Listening is the first step toward understanding—both God and others. It is in stillness and silence that we discover God's will. As Scripture reminds us, "Be still, and know that I am God" (Psalm 46:10). Listening is salvific. Like Mary, let us choose "the better part"—the path that leads to true intimacy with Christ and one another. Many of our failures in relationships and spiritual life stem from our haste to speak rather than to listen and understand.

This weekend, we warmly welcome Fr. Raymond, who is representing the Diocese of Massin in the Philippines. He will share with us stories of their missionary work and invite our support. Let us respond with generosity, remembering that we are part of the Church's global mission.

We also had a wonderful Vacation Bible School (VBS) this past week! I extend my heartfelt thanks to Rosie Roope and her dedicated team for organizing such a meaningful and joyful program for our children. A special word of thanks to our teens—your spirit and love for the Church were truly inspiring. Great job!

Our Parish 70th Jubilee concluding celebration will take place on Sunday, September 14, with the 10:00 AM Mass. The theme of our Jubilee year has been "Remember, Rejoice, and Renew." Below is information regarding Faith Formation programs offered at St. Francis Xavier Parish. For more information, please email Mrs. Rosie Roope at rosie.roope@sfxburbank.com.

SUNDAY SCHOOL—(For children in Pre-K or Kindergarten (ages 4-6) St. Francis has a Sunday School program designed just for them which meets during the 10:00 A.M. Mass. Using music, storytelling and crafts this program is designed to nurture young children's natural tendency to seek a relationship with God, reinforcing a strong sense of community and love. Parents drop their child off at 10am in the lower school building and pick up immediately following Mass. Fee: \$35.





RELIGIOUS EDUCATION AND SACRAMENTAL PREPARATION FOR ELEMENTARY-AGE CHILDREN - GRADES 1-5

This program is designed for children in public or non-Catholic schools. Baptized children typically begin sacramental preparation in first grade, celebrating First Reconciliation and First Holy Communion in second grade. However, children in grades 3–5 are also welcome to enroll. This is a two-year program. Classes meet on Wednesdays from 4:00 to 5:15 p.m., running from September through early May. Fee: \$125 per year.

RELIGIOUS EDUCATION AFTER FIRST COMMUNION Catholic education doesn't end with First Communion. Children in grades 3 through 5 continue to grow in their understanding of the many truths and traditions of our faith. In these classes, students learn to make moral choices and deepen their faith through Gospel dramatizations, discussions of current events, and original stories that connect Scripture to their own lives. The lives of the saints and imaginative activities help students see how the Gospel message can be lived out. Thoughtful "think" questions reinforce key doctrinal concepts. Classes meet Wednesdays from 4:00 to 5:15 p.m., running from September through mid-May. Fee \$125/year

CHILDREN'S LITURGY OF THE WORD (For children in the 1-3 Grade)

This program runs from late September through April during the 10:00 a.m. Sunday Mass. It offers children in grades 1-3 the opportunity to hear and understand the Sunday Gospel at their own age level. After the opening prayer at Mass, children are dismissed to a classroom in the lower school building, where they enjoy colorful activities and handouts that reinforce what they learn about God's Word from their adult leaders. They then return to the church to celebrate the Liturgy of the Eucharist with the rest of the parish family. This program is free and requires no registration.



CONFIRMATION (for high schoolers)

Confirmation is the final Sacrament of Initiation that brings your teen into full communion with the church. St. Francis Xavier follows a two-year preparation process for reception of this Sacrament designed to help our young people come to a deeper understanding of how the Holy Spirit works in our lives and in the life of the Church. Boys and girls begin the process anytime in their high school years, although most start as freshmen. Please visit our parish website for detailed information. Fee \$125/year

<u>ADULT CONFIRMATION</u>: Are you a baptized Catholic who has received First Communion and now wish to complete your full initiation into the Catholic Church? We warmly invite you to join our Adult Confirmation process—a meaningful journey of faith, learning, and spiritual growth. This process is designed for adults (18 and older, no longer in high school) who actively participate in parish life and are ready to deepen your commitment to Christ and the Church. Together, we'll explore the basics of Catholic teaching in a supportive and engaging environment. January—May, FEE \$50/year

OCIA— ORDER OF CHRISTIAN INITIATION FOR ADULTS AND CHILDREN

Are you yourself interested in becoming baptized in the Catholic Church, or completing your sacraments of First Eucharist and Confirmation? We have an excellent program for you - it is called OCIA. The St. Francis Xavier parish community invites you meet with members of the OCIA team who welcome your Interest and questions regarding the Catholic Church and our parish community.



OCIA FOR CHILDREN (AGES 7 AND ABOVE)

The Order of Christian Initiation of Adults adapted for Children (OCIA for Children) is designed for young people age 7 and older who have not been baptized or who were baptized in another Christian tradition and wish to become Catholic. Through age-appropriate catechesis, prayer, and participation in parish life, children prepare to receive the sacraments of Baptism (if needed), Confirmation, and First Holy Communion, typically celebrated at the Easter Vigil or during the Easter season. Who Can Participate:

- -Children age 7 and older who are not baptized
- -Children baptized in another Christian denomination who wish to enter the Catholic Church
- -Older children baptized Catholic but who have not received First Reconciliation or First Communion and need additional preparation

St. Francis Xavier School is currently accepting students entering Transitional Kindergarten through Eighth Grade in August 2025. All families who wish to have their children considered for Fall entrance are asked to contact the school office between the hours of 8:30 A.M. and 4:00 P.M., Monday through Friday.

In regard to Transitional Kindergarten and Kindergarten Applicants: Due to the difference between ability and maturity levels and the corresponding relationship to school readiness, Kindergarten applicants must turn 5 years old by November 1st to be eligible to take the entrance screening. Transitional Kindergarten applicants must turn 4 years old by November 1st to be eligible for the entrance screening.


