

From the Desk of Fr. Sebastian,

Dear Friends,

Time flies! We began our 70th Jubilee celebrations last November, and now we already find ourselves in the month of August. The concluding ceremony of our Jubilee Year will take place on Sunday, September 14th. While we mark the end of this special year, it is truly a new beginning for our parish and our shared journey of faith. It is an invitation to move forward with renewed enthusiasm and determination, keeping our vision bright and alive.

Our theme for the future is: "Faith in Action and Love in Motion." To prepare and equip us for this joyful journey, we have scheduled a three-part Tuesday evening series on August 12th, 19th, and 26th. This is open to everyone, and I warmly invite you to join us for "Igniting Our Faith" in the Holy Cross Hall, beginning each evening at 7:00 p.m.

In today's Gospel, Jesus tells us: "Be dressed for action and have your lamps lit" (Luke 12:35). He speaks of vigilance—not the vigilance of fear, but of love. It is the readiness of a servant who eagerly awaits the Master—not out of fear of punishment, but from the deep desire to serve and be in His presence. Vigilance is love in motion.

This coming Friday, August 15, we celebrate the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary—a Holy Day of Obligation. This feast reminds us of the final reward that awaits the faithful steward. In addition to our usual Mass schedule, there will be a special Mass at 7:00 p.m. I hope you can join us.

Below is information regarding Faith Formation programs offered at St. Francis Xavier Parish. For more information, please email Mrs. Rosie Roope at rosie.roope@sfxburbank.com.

SUNDAY SCHOOL—(For children in Pre-K or Kindergarten (ages 4-6) St. Francis has a Sunday School program designed just for them which meets during the 10:00 A.M. Mass. Using music, storytelling and crafts this program is designed to nurture young children's natural tendency to seek a relationship with God, reinforcing a strong sense of community and love. Parents drop their child off at 10am in the lower school building and pick up immediately following Mass. Fee: \$35.





RELIGIOUS EDUCATION AND SACRAMENTAL PREPARATION FOR ELEMENTARY-AGE CHILDREN - GRADES 1-5

This program is designed for children in public or non-Catholic schools. Baptized children typically begin sacramental preparation in first grade, celebrating First Reconciliation and First Holy Communion in second grade. However, children in grades 3–5 are also welcome to enroll. This is a two-year program. Classes meet on Wednesdays from 4:00 to 5:15 p.m., running from September through early May. Fee: \$125 per year.

RELIGIOUS EDUCATION AFTER FIRST COMMUNION Catholic education doesn't end with First Communion. Children in grades 3 through 5 continue to grow in their understanding of the many truths and traditions of our faith. In these classes, students learn to make moral choices and deepen their faith through Gospel dramatizations, discussions of current events, and original stories that connect Scripture to their own lives. The lives of the saints and imaginative activities help students see how the Gospel message can be lived out. Thoughtful "think" questions reinforce key doctrinal concepts. Classes meet Wednesdays from 4:00 to 5:15 p.m., running from September through mid-May. Fee \$125/year

CHILDREN'S LITURGY OF THE WORD (For children in the 1-3 Grade)

This program runs from late September through April during the 10:00 a.m. Sunday Mass. It offers children in grades 1-3 the opportunity to hear and understand the Sunday Gospel at their own age level. After the opening prayer at Mass, children are dismissed to a classroom in the lower school building, where they enjoy colorful activities and handouts that reinforce what they learn about God's Word from their adult leaders. They then return to the church to celebrate the Liturgy of the Eucharist with the rest of the parish family. This program is free and requires no registration.



CONFIRMATION (for high schoolers)

Confirmation is the final Sacrament of Initiation that brings your teen into full communion with the church. St. Francis Xavier follows a two-year preparation process for reception of this Sacrament designed to help our young people come to a deeper understanding of how the Holy Spirit works in our lives and in the life of the Church. Boys and girls begin the process anytime in their high school years, although most start as freshmen. Please visit our parish website for detailed information. Fee \$125/year

<u>ADULT CONFIRMATION</u>: Are you a baptized Catholic who has received First Communion and now wish to complete your full initiation into the Catholic Church? We warmly invite you to join our Adult Confirmation process—a meaningful journey of faith, learning, and spiritual growth. This process is designed for adults (18 and older, no longer in high school) who actively participate in parish life and are ready to deepen your commitment to Christ and the Church. Together, we'll explore the basics of Catholic teaching in a supportive and engaging environment. January—May, FEE \$50/year

OCIA— ORDER OF CHRISTIAN INITIATION FOR ADULTS AND CHILDREN

Are you yourself interested in becoming baptized in the Catholic Church, or completing your sacraments of First Eucharist and Confirmation? We have an excellent program for you - it is called OCIA. The St. Francis Xavier parish community invites you meet with members of the OCIA team who welcome your Interest and questions regarding the Catholic Church and our parish community.



OCIA FOR CHILDREN (AGES 7 AND ABOVE)

The Order of Christian Initiation of Adults adapted for Children (OCIA for Children) is designed for young people age 7 and older who have not been baptized or who were baptized in another Christian tradition and wish to become Catholic. Through age-appropriate catechesis, prayer, and participation in parish life, children prepare to receive the sacraments of Baptism (if needed), Confirmation, and First Holy Communion, typically celebrated at the Easter Vigil or during the Easter season. Who Can Participate:

- -Children age 7 and older who are not baptized
- -Children baptized in another Christian denomination who wish to enter the Catholic Church
- -Older children baptized Catholic but who have not received First Reconciliation or First Communion and need additional preparation

DID YOU KNOW?

Far-reaching Effects of Child Abuse

Children who suffer from sexual abuse run a greater risk of negative associated outcomes, not only with their mental health, but also suicidal tendencies, potential future abuse, more cognitive deficits, or lower educational interests and efforts. Abused children also are at higher risk for eating disorders, obesity, early onset of puberty, or chronic health issues. Ultimately, abuse has far-reaching consequences beyond childhood for many victims, and it is critical to act quickly to protect potential victims. It's important to remember that any intervention or supportive response from a safe adult can reduce the risk of many or all negative outcomes. 
