RELIGIOUS EDUCATION - REGISTRATIONS

The Office of Religious Education will begin registering for the 2022-2023 year from June 1-22, Monday through Friday from 10am-5pm. We will be registering by appointment only. Please call the office at, 209-892-6381 to schedule your appointment from May 23-31. Please note the following requirements.

Preparation for Reconciliation/First Communion: Registration Fee is \$60 per year

This is a two-year preparation program.

Child must be at least in 2nd grade or beginning 2nd grade in September.

- * **We must have a copy of the child's Baptism Certificate.**
- * **The family must be registered parishioners.**

Preparation for Confirmation: Registration fee is \$80 per year, (this includes the retreat fee.)

Candidate must be at least in 6th grade or beginning the 6th grade in September.

This is a two-year preparation program. Candidates will receive preparation classes the first two years but will receive confirmation the following year and will be required to attend classes to make-up any that were missed during the two-year preparation as well as talks on the Rite of Confirmation.

As before, we do not offer a one-year preparation course for High School Juniors and Seniors. Junior and Seniors are welcome to begin preparation in our classes, but the second year of preparation may be continued in RCIA, (Rite of Christian Initiation for Adults), and are subject to RCIA guidelines.

- * We must have a copy of the candidate's Baptism and First Communion Certificates
- * The family must be registered parishioners.

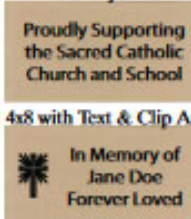

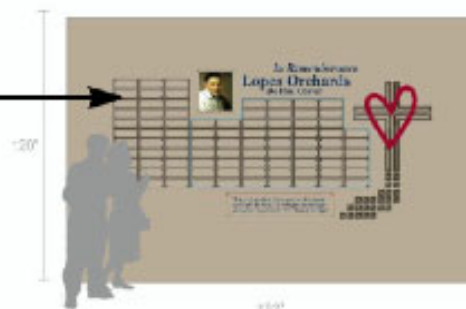
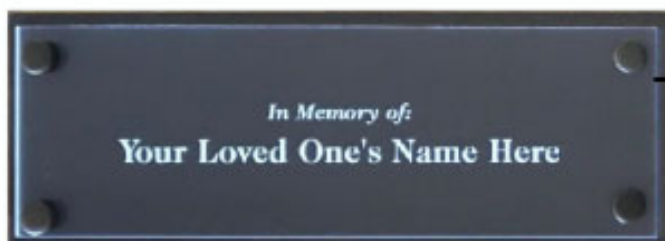
