The Schumaker's Bench



First, I would like to congratulate all the students who made their First Holy Communion this weekend. What a great joy it is to be able to celebrate with them, and especially on such a fitting weekend when we celebrate the Feast of Corpus Christi, or rather, the Feast of the Body and Blood of Jesus Christ. This is the feast of the Sacrament of Sacraments, the source and summit of Christian life. Pope Saint John Paul II said this in his Letter on the Eucharist in 2003.

I wrote this encyclical in continuity with my writings on the New Millennium and on the Rosary to rekindle a Eucharistic "amazement". I want the Church to contemplate the face of Christ with Mary. This means to recognized Christ in events and in His many forms of presence, especially in the Eucharist where the faithful relive the experiences of

the two disciples who "recognized Jesus in the breaking of the bread". I want to involve the whole church more fully in this Eucharistic reflection. Halting before the "Eucharistic face" of Christ, I want to highlight the centrality of the Eucharist and urge everyone to experience anew this "living bread", the Church's own nourishment...

In the Eucharistic celebration, this central event of the Lord's death and resurrection becomes really present. This sacrifice is so decisive that Jesus returned to the Father only after He had given us a means to share in the sacrifice (as if we had been present). Now, for centuries, members of the faithful have enjoyed this gift. What more could Jesus have done for us? In the Eucharist, He has loved us "to the end" ...

The church draws her life through a real contact with this redeeming sacrifice. Because the sacrifice of Christ and of the Eucharist are the same, Christ's reconciliation is applied to men and women of today. "we always offer the same Lamb, not one today and another tomorrow, but always the same one". Therefore, the mass does not add to or multiply Christ's sacrifice. The mass, a "commemorative representation", makes this sacrifice always present in time...it refers directly to the sacrifice of Calvary.

The Eucharist is in the strict sense, a sacrifice, not just Christ giving himself to us. His gift is first of all to the Father, then for our sake and for all humanity... We must offer ourselves in union with Him. The (Second


