- In submitting your weddings request for permission or dispensations please remember that we require at least a 5 month notice so that we can prepare the necessary papers should a special case is needed to be handled! We can discuss details over the phone especially when you have problems to solve about a wedding but it's good to talk them well in advance so that we might be able to solve them!
- **Tribunal matters (annulment petitions, etc.)** check out the Maronite website http://www.stmaron.org/eparchy/marriage-tribunal/ for forms and answers to your questions you need more details call the Tribunal

- Salary increases to Priests - based on years of priesthood!

Dear brothers in Christ – just wanted to remind everyone of the policy that is still in use from the Typikon. Every priest in our Diocese gets a salary increase every 5 years. The increase is \$50 more to your monthly salary. For all those celebrating 5, 10, 15, 20, 25, 30, etc. years of priesthood this year an increase in your salary will take place after you have passed your anniversary date. Please refer to the Typikon still in use for this rule. (Pastoral Typikon #103.)

As of November 2023, everyone who was ordained prior to November 1, 2018 will benefit from the increase automatically.

Synod Overview

The Church is called to "renew herself under the action of the Spirit and by listening to the Word". (Synod Preparatory Document, page 12)"we recall that the purpose of the Synod, and therefore of this consultation, is not to produce documents, but to plant dreams, draw forth prophecies and visions, allow hope to flourish, inspire trust, bond up wounds, weave together relationships, awaken a dawn of hope, learn from one another and create a bright resourcefulness that will enlighten minds, warm hearts, give strength to our hands..." (Synod Preparatory Document, page 40).

Different articulations of Synodality – is the style with which the Church ordinarily lives and expresses its nature through listening to the Word and celebrating the Eucharist, brotherhood of communion and co-responsibility and participation of the whole People of God in its life and mission, on all levels.

"A synodal Church, in announcing the Gospel, "journeys together:" How is this "journeying together" happening today in our Church? What steps does the Spirit invite us to take in order to grow in our "journeying together"?"

Discussion – Which of the below statements would you like to discuss further?

• Pastors are "authentic guardians, interpreters and witnesses of the faith of the whole Church. This is not democracy of the majority. (Francis, address for the ceremony

- commemorating the 50th anniversary of the institution of the Synod of Bishops, 10/17/2015).
- Through Jesus "faith emerges as a valuing of people; their plea is heard, their difficulty helped, their availability appreciated, their dignity is appreciated, their dignity is confirmed by God's gaze and restored to the community's recognition". (Synod 2021 2023 Preparatory Document, page 20).
- Can you imagine some type of mission/renewal for your church community over this next year? How are the gifts of the Holy Spirit discerned and organized in your community? (Everyone has a gift)

<u>Ideas Our Faithful to Discuss</u> - These are statements from Pope Francis to the Faithful of the Diocese of Rome on 9/18/2021 regarding this Synod. Which statement can you imagine discussing? Why?

- Once the church stops (as journeying has since the first Apostles), she is no longer Church, but a lovely pious association, for she keeps the Holy Spirit in a cage.
- Gustav Mahler once stated that fidelity to tradition does not consist in worshiping ashes but in keeping a fire burning.
- We need to keep the doors and windows of the Church wide open. Go out and meet them, let them question you, let their questions become your questions...do not be afraid to engage in dialogue and even to be taken aback by what you hear, for this is the dialogue of salvation.
- Journey together: trust in the Spirit. Do you feel like you are part of one great people which has received God's promises for a future in which all are invited to partake of the banquet God has prepared for every people (Isiah 25:6)?
- Being God's people is not a privilege, but a gift that we receive not for ourselves, but for everyone. The Holy Spirit in His freedom knows no boundaries or tests of admission.

It seems good to the Holy Spirit and us....

Let our prayer be..."Holy Spirit, soul of my soul, I adore Thee. Enlighten me, guide me, strengthen and comfort me.

Tell me what I ought to do and order me to it. I promise to submit to anything that you require from me,
