





October is National Anti-Bullying Month

Bullying is a form of aggressive behavior in which someone intentionally and repeatedly causes another person injury or discomfort. Bullying can take the form of physical contact, words or more subtle actions. The bullied individual typically has trouble defending him or herself and does nothing to "cause" the bullying. Many kids who are bullied feel helpless. Sometimes, they think the only thing they can do is hope the problem will go away. There are things you, as an adult, can do to get some control in the situation. Here are some warning signs that your child is being bullied:

They show signs of anxiety or fear of going to school, riding the bus or walking to and from school.

Takes the long way to school.

Has few or no friends that he spends time with or talks about.

Has a loss of interest in school or a drop in grades.

Comes home with torn, damaged or missing clothing or possessions.

Has unexplained cuts, scratches or bruises.

Has trouble sleeping or has a loss of appetite

Suffers from low self-esteem.

Complains frequently of headaches/stomachaches and looks for reasons not to go to school.

Appears sad, moody or depressed after school.

WHAT CAN YOU DO?

Talk to your child and ask him/her questions such as: Who do you sit with on the bus or at lunch? Are there kids at school you really don't like? If so, who? Are there kids that talk to you in a mean way? Is someone bullying you?

Look into community organizations that build confidence and character: i.e.: positive play dates, karate, ballet, gymnastics, mentoring.

Talk to school staff regarding your child's involvement in the class and ask the teacher to be on the lookout for types of bullying.

Talk to child's school bus driver.

If you don't feel satisfied with the teacher, go to the school's counselor or Principal. Ask questions and keep the communication lines open. Document everything. Remind your child that reporting a bully is not snitching. People who report bullying are doing the right thing and the reality is adults can't address the problem if they don't know about it. **ENCOURAGE YOUR CHILD TO STAND UP AND SPEAK OUT!** Excerpts from www.AntiBullyingCoalition.org.
