

Fr. Ron's Ramblings


This weekend we celebrate the feast of the Dedication of the Lateran Basilica in Rome. This feast usually falls on a weekday but this year, as with some other feasts, it happens to occur on a Sunday and takes precedence over our usual Sunday celebration. This is an important feast in the history of our church because this cathedral is some sixteen hundred years old and was the site of many significant events, including four ecumenical councils.

As with very old houses, within the walls of old churches years and years of history live. As we look around our own St. Michael's, we can only imagine the number of people who have passed this way and worshipped God. The sheer numbers would be staggering. How many began their lives of faith through the Sacraments of Baptism, Holy Eucharist, and Confirmation?; How many couples walked down this center aisle to be united in the Sacrament of Matrimony?; How many were returned to God with their funeral Masses?

Walking through the church and looking at the memorials on the stained glass windows, most names are unfamiliar yet they were very real people who treasured their faith and their church.

I am also struck by the number of immigrants who passed this way. Having left the familiarity of their homeland, they found comfort and solace in the universality of their Catholic faith. And even to this day, many of those from Brazil and Portugal continue to find that place of belonging in St. Michael's Church.

Today, on this feast, we therefore celebrate our own church building and the myriad number of faithful who have come this way. May we continue to provide that place of comfort and solace in the midst of the fast paced world in which we live.

Ainda hoje em dia os brasileiros continuam a encontrar o lugar que pertencem na nossa paróquia de São Miguel.

Hoje nesta festa celebramos o edificio da nossa própria igreja e o elevado numero de pessoas de fé que já passaram por ca. Que nós continuemos a providenciar o lugar de conforto e consolo envolvidos neste mundo de ritmo apressado em que vivemos.



November is National Alzheimer's Awareness Month

Alzheimer's is the most common form of dementia, a general term for memory loss and other intellectual abilities, serious enough to interfere with daily life. This disease accounts for 60-80% of dementia cases. It is not a normal part of aging, although the greatest known risk factor is increasing age, and the majority of people with Alzheimer's are 65 and older. Up to 5% of people with the disease have early onset, also known as younger-onset, which often appears when someone is in their 40's and 50's. This disease worsens over time. In its early stages, memory loss is mild, but with late-stage disease, individuals lose the ability to carry on a conversation and respond to their environment. There is no current cure for Alzheimer's but treatments can temporarily slow the worsening of dementia symptoms and improve quality of life for those with Alzheimer's.

If you or a loved one has been diagnosed with Alzheimer's or a related dementia, **YOU ARE NOT ALONE**. 10 Warning Signs of Alzheimer's

1. Memory loss that disrupts daily life, such as forgetting important dates or events, asking for the same information over and over and increasing need to rely on memory aids.
2. Challenges in planning or solving problems, such as following a familiar recipe or keeping track of monthly bills.
3. Difficulty completing familiar tasks at home, at work or at leisure.
4. Confusion with time or place. i.e. lose track of dates, seasons and the passage of time.
5. Trouble understanding visual images and spatial relationships. They have difficulty reading, judging distance and determining color.
6. New problems with words in speaking or writing. One may have trouble following or joining a conversation and have trouble finding the right word.
7. Misplacing things and losing the ability to retrace steps.
8. One may experience changes in judgment or decision making.
9. Withdrawal from work or social activities.
10. Changes in mood and personality. One can become confused, suspicious, depressed, fearful and anxious.


