

ST. PHOEBE, DEACON OF THE CHURCH, WE REMEMBER YOU!

Today we remember St. Phoebe, whose feast day is September 3. Known as the first woman deacon of the Church, she was entrusted by Paul to deliver his letter to the Romans, which begins, "I commend to you our sister Phoebe, a deacon of the church at Cenchrae, so that you may welcome her in the Lord as is fitting for the saints, and help her in whatever she may require of you, for she has been a benefactor of many and myself as well. (Romans 16:1-2)

We are grateful that we have scriptural reference of Phoebe, which names her and her role! It has helped to shine the light on the diaconal vocation of women in our time. All too often, women in scripture have gone nameless, or if their names are written at all, we certainly never hear their names on Sunday. I have been profoundly moved to learn the names of these New Testament women, and so I name them here:

Priscilla - she assembled a church in her home in Ephesus along with her husband Aquila (Acts 18, and Rom 16:3)

Dorcas - a weaver of clothes for the needy in Joppa, in the time of Paul. (Acts 9:36-42)

Junia - prominent among the apostles and sharing imprisonment with Paul, along with her husband Andronicus. (Romans 16:7)

Chloe - a woman of Corinth who advised Paul. (1 Cor 1:11)

Lydia - who founded the church in Philippi. (Acts 16: 14-15, 40)

Damaris - who heard Paul's message in Athens (Acts 17:34)

Meals are included for Saturday thru Sunday breakfast.


