Starting August 2026, St. Stephen Protomartyr school will be offering a PK2 class!

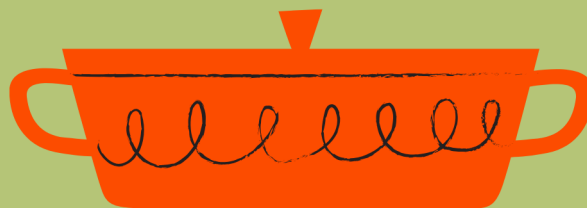
