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January 2022 will be upon us in a heartbeat. The Board of Education wanted me to remind SSP parents of some uniform restrictions beginning in the new calendar year.

# SSP Uniform Short Sheet

Students are expected to be well-groomed at all times and in compliance with the school uniform code. Please see the school handbook for full details.



## Please note the following changes to begin January 2022:

- black sweatshirts are no longer allowed on regular uniform days
- black polos will be the only color approved for girls to wear
- No logo t-shirts on regular uniform days. (May be worn on PE days.)
- 90th anniversary t-shirts may no longer be worn

## Pants & Shorts

Shorts: Knee-length and neatly hemmed  
Pants and shorts: Navy blue



Boys & Girls may wear navy pants & shorts

Pant length: must be at least long enough to touch the tops of one's shoe.

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## Belt

black, brown, or navy



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## Polos



Girls: Black polo  
Boys: Red polo



Any t-shirt worn under a uniform shirt must be plain white

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## SSP Sweatshirts / Jackets



- Red SSP sweatshirts
- Red school fleece jacket
- Grey school quarter-zip sweatshirt

## Exceptions:

- 8th grade may wear class shirts; and after acceptance letters are received high school sweatshirts may be worn on designated days
- Only 8th grade girls may wear nail polish
- 8th grade may wear their choice of sock color
- SSP Logo t-shirts may be worn on PE days

## Girls Only Plaids



Girls' Jumpers: PreK – 4th Grades  
Girls' Skirts: 4th – 8th Grades

*Skirt and jumper length: must be longer than the students fingertips when arms are at their sides*


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## Bottoms

- Black tights or black leggings (no more than 2 inches above ankle)
- Shorts that do not extend past the skirt

## Sock and Shoes

- Athletic shoes preferred (see handbook for more details)
- Athletic shoes may be any color
- Shoes must be in good condition with the laces tied

*No outdoor hiking boots, snow boots, dress boots, moccasins, Ugg-type boots, flip-flops, high-heeled shoes, or any shoes that fall off easily.*

## Hair, Make-up & Nails

- Students' hair should look natural and well-groomed, not extreme or distracting. Color should look natural.
- No makeup is allowed on regular or dress-down days.
- One or two pairs of post earrings may be worn by girls. Dangling or hoop earrings are not allowed. Boys may not wear earrings.


