## From the Finance Committee - Extended Care Rates 2023-2024

Many of you have inquired about the previously advertised pricing structure of choosing one of three extended care plans: Unlimited, 3-days per week, or \$25 per pay. After careful consideration, the Finance Committee determined it was best to return to an hourly rate per student who utilizes the Extended Care Program. Effective November 2, 2023, the hourly rate is \$9 per hour, per student. #### CHORAL CLUB is about to begin!

#### All 3rd through 8th graders are invited to join Choral Club 2023!

Choral Club is a seasonal, fun, learning, informal, choir experience for SSP students in grades 3-8.

We want to bring the spirit of the Advent and Christmas season to the community just as we have in years past. We have had many students in the Choral Club for a number of years and we are hoping that many students join again this year. Students will learn to sing together in unison and in parts, as well as play bells and other instruments. We hope that student instrumentalists will also contribute to the joyous sound. Some music will be new, and some music will be old favorites. We always learn and have fun!

PRACTICES: In the Music Room or Church on Thursday and/or Friday starting October 12. We will begin with 3-5th grade on Thursday and 6-8th grade on Friday. The first few weeks we will have short practices 2:45-3:00 but we will go to longer practices in November. We will dismiss at 3:00pm.

Beginning October 16, we plan to post music online in the Choral Club Classroom so that students can sing along with pre-recorded music. This will help students learn their part.

#### Our 2023 plan is not completely finalized but here are some ideas:

- We will have outdoor and indoor performances. Stay tuned for dates and locations. Let us know if students or parents have any ideas for venues that we might investigate.
- It is likely that we will have both in-school-time and outside of school-time (evening or weekends) events. Students will be expected to attend events and practices when possible.
- We will possibly make a video to share with the parish, community or families especially those who are distant.
- We are planning for all <u>available</u> Choral Club members to sing at the SSP parish 10:00 AM Advent Mass on Dec 17 at IHM and at the 5:00 PM Mass at SSP on Christmas Eve. (Note: There will be a practice for Christmas Eve at SSP at noon with the adult choir after the Advent Mass on Dec. 17.)

All the plans depend on who joins, when they are available, and what they would like to sing. We can't wait!

The permission form is a separate form also coming home today and must be returned to the school office by Wednesday, Oct 11. Students in the Choral Club will get an email with a link to join the Choral Club Google Classroom. Details for practice, performances, and music to learn will be posted in the Google Classroom and we also be sent to parents by email.

#### St. Stephen Protomartyr Choral Club 2023 PERMISSION FORM


I have read the Choral Club 2023 Information sheet and my student would like to join the Choral Club. I understand that:

- Choral Club practices and performances will in most cases be optional masking with distancing as much as possible. Students may need to mask for special situations or venues.
- My student(s) will commit to learning music at practice or via the Google Classroom.
- A calendar of events will be posted as soon as it is finalized. Events may be during school or outside of school time.
- My student(s) will attend all practices and performances unless they are absent from school or parents have notified the directors.
- There will be specific permission forms for field trips. There may be minimal cost of transportation.
- Communications regarding Choral Club will come by FACTS. Some info will be posted on the School Facebook site and in the Choral Club Google Classroom.
- Available students will sing at 5:00PM Christmas Eve Mass this year. (In places in church by 4:30.
- Choral Club shirts will be distributed to students for performances. There will be a charge of \$15 if the shirt is not returned at the end of the season.
- By giving permission for my child(ren) to participate, I understand that my child's image or video/audio recording will be utilized and shared with the parish / school community as well as nursing homes and any other beneficiaries of our talents. This will usually be facilitated by our parish website and parish and school social media channels, such as Facebook and YouTube. I understand that my child will not be identified by name in videos or photographs.


