

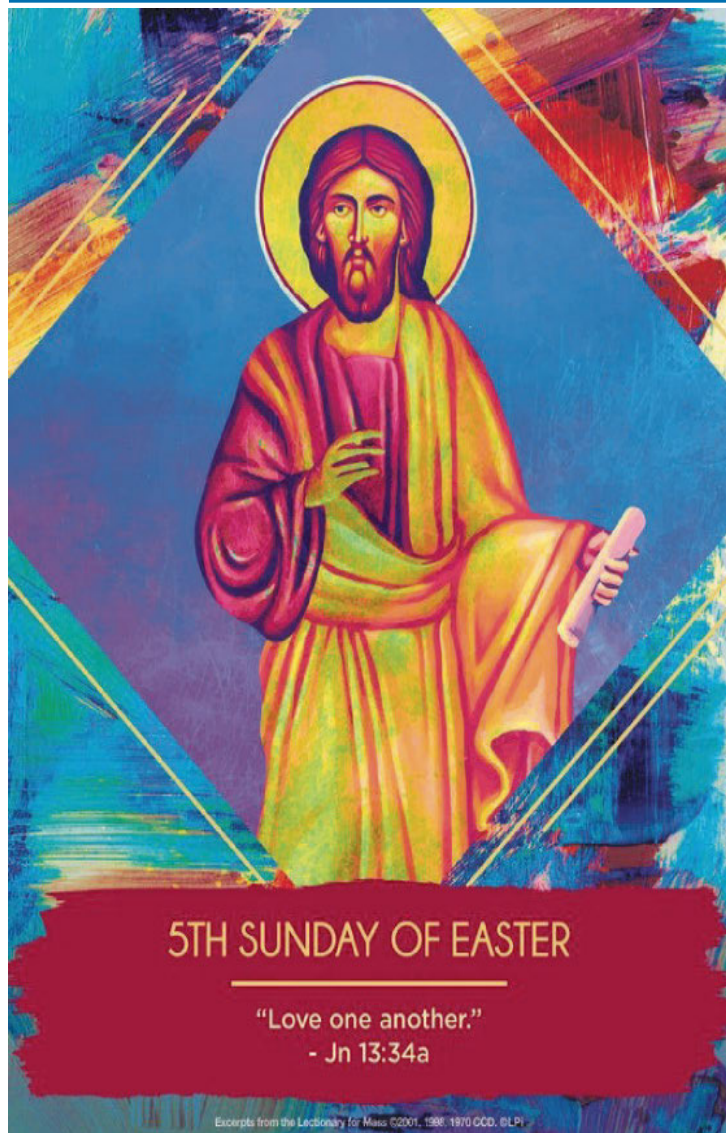

Pastor's Word

For the past three weeks we have had John's vision of the heavenly liturgy where he has seen the eternal sacrifice being offered to God the Father by Jesus Christ. Now John describes the Heavenly Jerusalem. It was Jesus' mission to go to the earthly Jerusalem to offer His sacrifice—this shows us the path that we must follow to reach the Heavenly Jerusalem so that we can dwell with Him there forever.

As we are going to have election for the Parish Council, we will see some changes. These changes are but a continuity of the same mission of serving Corpus Christi Church. Being in the Parish Council is an opportunity to be humble and put oneself at the last place so that the Corpus Christi could move and puts herself in the service of the least of the brothers and sisters of Christ.

Jesus says: "I give you a new commandment: love one another; just as I have loved you, you also must love one another." (Jn 13:34) Being the children of God "love one another just as Jesus has loved us", is the only thing that matters.

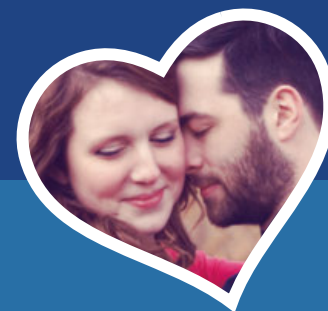

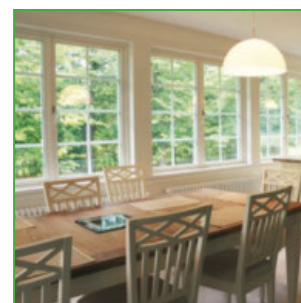
