


Safe Environment

In an effort to support a safe environment, the Archdiocese of OKC adopted an online training program which addresses five separate areas: Recognizing and Preventing Child Abuse; Professional Behaviors and Boundaries; Elderly Abuse; Domestic Abuse; and Human Trafficking

Each year, volunteers along with church ministry and church leadership are required to complete a training session in one of these areas. There is a Safe Environment Facilitator available to assist those who may need it. The certification is valid from August 1st, 2025 through July 31st, 2026. Pastor's Word

The Holy Trinity invites us to live in the awareness of the presence on the Triune God within us: The Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit. The mystery of the Holy Trinity is one of the fundamental doctrines of Christianity and the greatest mystery of our Faith, namely, that there are Three Divine Persons, sharing the same Divine Nature in one God. "There is one God, who has three Persons, Father, Son and Holy Spirit. Each Person is God, yet there is still only one God" (CCC #234, #253-256)

We have the Father Who is the Creator, the Son Who is the Redeemer and the Holy Spirit Who is the Sanctifier and the Counselor. The doctrine of the Holy Trinity is not explicitly spelt out in the Bible. But it underlies all major Christian feasts (Christmas, the Epiphany, Good Friday, Easter, the Ascension and Pentecost). All the official prayers of the Church, including the Holy Mass and the Sacraments, begin with the address to the Holy Trinity: "In the Name of the Father and the Son and of the Holy Spirit."

We are baptized, our sins are absolved, and we are anointed in the Name of the Blessed Trinity. Throughout the world, when Church bells ring three times a day for the Angelus, or (in the Easter Season), the *Regina Coeli*, Christians are invited to pray to God the Father; God the Son; and God the Holy Spirit, giving glory to the Triune God for the Incarnation of the Son and our Redemption through His suffering and death.

Todays readings convey the fundamental mystery that the Triune God reaches out to people with love, seeking the deepest communion with them.

Let us respect ourselves and others because everyone is the temple of the Holy Spirit where all Three Persons of the Holy Trinity abide. Let us practice the Trinitarian relationship of love and unity in the family relationships of father, mother, and children because by Baptism we become children of God and members of God's Trinitarian family.

The Feast of Corpus Christi — The **Body of Christ** — will be celebrated on June 22nd at the 11:00 Mass. The feast is in remembrance of the Last Supper where we receive God's Body and God's Blood.

There will be a parish cookout following the mass.

We ask parishioners to bring a covered dish or dessert. The church will provide the meat and beverages.

There will be no 1:00 pm Zomi mass on the Feast Day.
