



Notice on Security Changes During Mass
In lieu of the ever increasing assaults on our public, religious, and governmental gathering places, we are taking steps to secure our worship environment during all Sunday Masses and any Masses celebrated throughout the liturgical year. Effectively immediately, the main doors facing the Kelly Street side will be locked after 11:05 AM and 1:05 PM and reopened at the end of Mass. Anyone arriving after this time will need to enter through the North doors on the parking lot

side. Security will be posted at these doors

Pastor's Word

My sisters and brothers in Christ,

The Liturgical Year after the Christmas season and now we are advancing into 23rd Week.. As time passes, we grow and become adult by now in our faith journey. The Word of God invites us this week, "If anyone comes to me without hating his father and mother, wife and children, brothers and sisters, and even his whole life, he cannot be my disciple." Now that we are shaken by this teaching, what is Jesus' message today? Whoever does not carry his own cross and come after me cannot be my disciple. There is nothing half-hearted about following Jesus. We will face opposition, and we will have to carry a cross—our personal cross, a suffering and burden uniquely our own. Is following Christ worth this radical and uncomfortable lifestyle change? Discipleship means discernment. Anyone who wishes to construct a tower, first sit down and calculate the cost to see if there is enough for its completion. We'd better know what we're doing before we can follow Christ. To make such a decision, Today's First Reading gives us some guidance.

"Who can know God's counsel, or who can conceive what the Lord intends? For the deliberations of mortals are timid and unsure are our plans...Or who ever knew your counsel, except you had given wisdom and sent your **holy spirit** from on high? And thus were the paths of those on earth made straight."

To follow Christ means facing opposition and carrying a difficult cross. But Jesus has faith that we will make the right decision—a decision we must ponder carefully with the inspiration of the Holy Spirit. But Jesus makes clear, 'If you wish to be perfect, go, sell what you have and give to (the) poor, and you have treasure in heaven. Then come, follow me." (Mt. 19:21)
