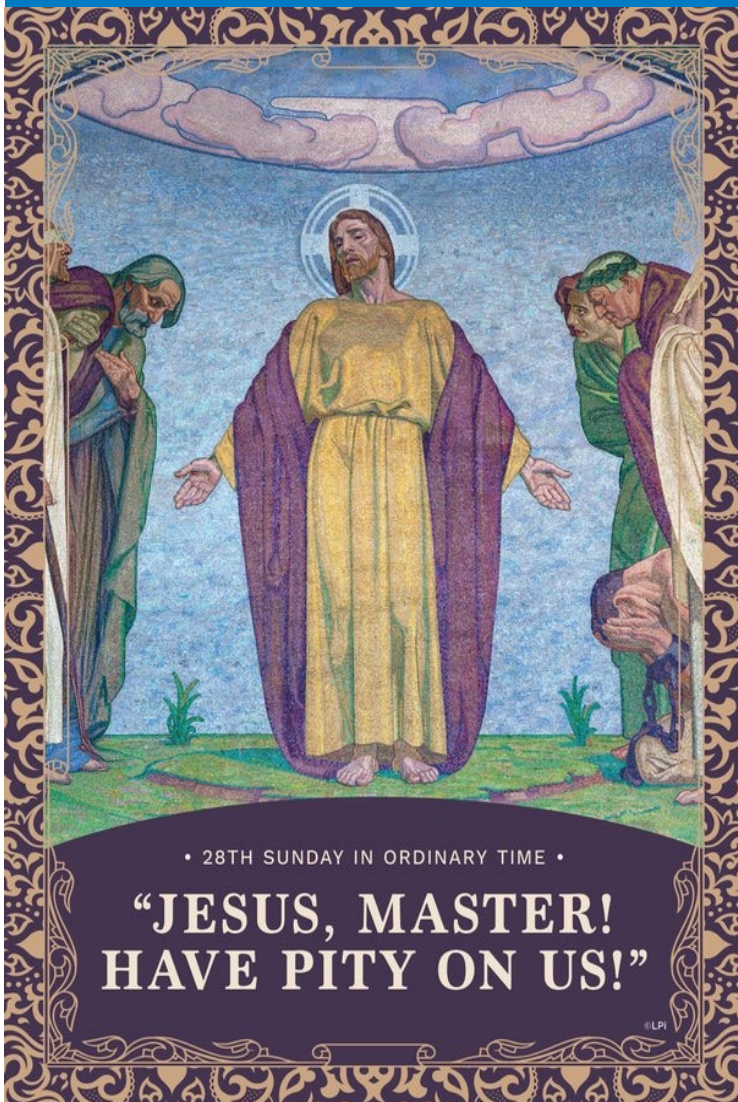

Notice on Security Changes During Mass

In lieu of the ever increasing assaults on our public, religious and governmental gathering places, we are taking steps to secure our worship environment during all Sunday Masses and any Masses celebrated throughout the liturgical year.

Effective immediately, the main doors facing the Kelley Avenue side will be locked after 11:05 AM and 1:05 PM and reopened at the end of Mass. Anyone arriving after this time will need to enter through the North doors on the parking lot side. Security will be posted at these doors and someone will monitor the parking lots. Please do not attempt to enter through the main doors after 11:05 AM or 1:05PM.

We also ask that you remain vigilant, not put yourself or family in harms way and report any suspicious activity to the security that we will have in place.

Pastor's Word

Gratitude and Faith in Action..

The readings for the 28th Sunday in Ordinary Time Year C talk about healing, faith and gratitude. They show how we should respond to God's help and how faith brings wholeness.

Naaman is healed after listening to the prophet Elisha. He chooses to follow the God of Israel. It is not the quality of the water but obedience to the Prophet's words that healed Naaman. Healing comes only from God. Naaman at first doubts but then obeys and is healed. Naaman returns to thank Elisha after being healed.

In the Gospel, ten lepers come to meet Jesus and called to him, "Jesus! Master! Take pity on us." Jesus tells them to go and show themselves to the priests. Now as they are on their way they are cleansed. Finding himself cured, one of them turns back praising God at the top of his voice and throws himself at the feet of Jesus and thanks him. Ten lepers are healed, but only one comes back to thank Jesus. This man, a Samaritan, shows true faith by giving thanks.

Only one of the ten lepers thanks Jesus, showing that many forget to be grateful. The Samaritan leper trusts Jesus, returns to give thanks, and is told his faith has saved him, showing that God brings both physical and spiritual healing.

Naaman is not an Israelite, but God still heals him. The one grateful leper is a Samaritan, showing that God's love is for everyone.

Faith is not just believing but also saying thank you to God. Today, we are invited to look at our own lives. We can ask if we thank God enough for His care and love.

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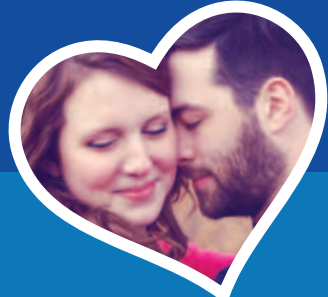
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
