Weekly Reflection from Fr. Pau

The Baptism of the Lord is the public revelation of the Three Persons in the Holy Trinity and the official revelation of Jesus as the Son of God to the world by God the Father. It marks the beginning of Jesus' public ministry.

The opening of the Heavens with Holy Spirit, descending as a dove upon Jesus, and the Voice declaring of him, "*This is My beloved Son with Whom I am well pleased,*" are God's revelation to mankind of the Mystery that He is Triune. The presence of the Triune God at this baptism, reveals Jesus' true identity and mission. The Heavens' opening also indicates that this was a moment of God's powerful intervention in human history and in the life of His Son.

The baptism of Jesus reminds us of who we are and Whose we are. Baptism is the gateway to the other sacraments, the foundation of Christian life. It's the first sacrament of initiation, essential for receiving others and entering full communion with the Church. By Baptism we become sons and daughters of God, brothers and sisters of Jesus, members of his Church, heirs of heaven and temples of the Holy Spirit.

Jesus' baptism reminds us also of our baptism that makes us experience the presence of God within us, to acknowledge our own dignity as God's children, and to appreciate the Divine Presence in others by loving them and serving them in humility.

By the grace of Baptism, we can live as the children of God in thought, word and action and lead a holy and transparent Christian life and not to desecrate our bodies which is the temple of the Holy Spirit and members of Jesus' Body, by impurity, injustice, intolerance, jealousy or hatred.

Let us grow daily in intimacy with God by personal and family prayers, by meditative reading of the Word of God, by participating in the Holy Mass, and by frequenting the Sacrament of Reconciliation.

Let us renew our Baptismal promises and continue to live as God's *beloved children with Whom He is well pleased!*

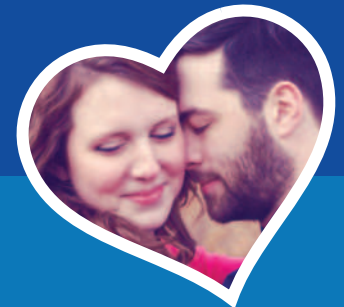
