

Weekly Reflection from Fr. Pau

The witness that John the Baptist bears to Jesus can be seen as the revelation and identification of Jesus as the “*Lamb of God*”, and the call to discipleship.

John the Baptist knows that Jesus is the Son of God and calls Him both the “*Lamb of God*” and the “*Son of God*.”

In preparing the way for Jesus and in making him known to the world, John the Baptist shows us that our discipleship is a call to make Jesus known to the world by our words, by our witness and by our actions. Doing the sign of the cross in the name of the Father, Son and Holy Spirit, reminds us of our identity as God’s Sons and daughters first bestowed upon us at baptism.

Let us live like a lamb by leading pure, humble, selfless lives, obedient to Christ’s commandment of love; and die like a sacrificial lamb by sharing our blessings of health, wealth, and talents with others and bearing witness to Christ in our illness and suffering; and offering them for the salvation of souls, in reparation for our sins and those of the whole world.

The Gospel reminds us that being a disciple of Jesus means that we need to grow in Faith so that we can become effective witnesses for him. Bearing witness to Christ is an active and a lifetime enterprise.

Jesus invites us to “*Come and see.*” The essence to witnessing is to state what we have seen and believed and then to invite others to “*come and see*” Jesus for themselves and, so, become the disciples with us. As with Andrew and John, our Faith begins with our responding to Jesus’ invitation to “*come and see.*”

We tell others about good restaurants, barbers, optometrists, etc. Why isn’t there the same fervor over inviting and encouraging people to come and participate in our Church activities?

Lent is just around the corner and we will prepare for it with a Penance Service on Wednesday, March 11th. Mark your calendars and we hope you will plan to participate in the sacrament of reconciliation
