Security Cameras Are In Place

The security cameras have been installed at the entrances to the church and the altar area. This provides video coverage of the immediate areas near the church doors where ushers will have access to in the foyer.

Please note: With the installation, we are updating our security procedures. All doors coming into the church will be locked 15 mins. after Mass begins. After the 15 min. timeframe, anyone who needs to enter the church using the handicap ramp will be seen on the monitor and one of the ushers will unlock the handicapped (North) entrance. All individuals not requiring use of the ramp should enter at the West entrance (if you are more than 15 minutes late and the ushers will let you in. If you arrive, after the doors have been closed, or if a reading is taking place, the ushers will hold you at the door until such readings / or homily is completed. At that point please proceed down the side aisle and PLEASE avoid walking across the altar or down the middle aisle. These procedures are initiated to reduce disruptions and distractions during this liturgical ritual.

Weekly Reflection from Fr. Pau

On the 30th of April, 2000, Pope St. John Paul II canonized Blessed Sister Faustina. She invites us to keep our Faith and Hope fixed on God the Father, rich in mercy, who saved us by the precious Blood of His Son, Jesus.

The Lord Jesus assigned to St. Faustina to pray for souls, entrusting them to God's incomprehensible Mercy; to tell the world about God's generous Mercy; and to start a new movement in the church focusing on God's Mercy.

God revealed His mercy to the world by sending His Only-begotten Son to become our Savior and Lord by His suffering, death, and Resurrection. Divine Mercy is offered to us in the Holy Mass, the Sacrament of Reconciliation and celebration of each of the Sacraments.

Acts 2:42-47, shows us how the early Church grew every day because of the acts of mercy and sharing, sacrificial *agape* love, practiced by the early Christians. They expressed their love and mercy by sharing what they had with everyone in need.

As we recall Jesus' appearance to the Apostles on that first Easter evening, we are vividly reminded of the Sacrament of Reconciliation—the power to forgive sins which Our Lord gave to His Apostles, saying, “*Whose sins you forgive, they are forgiven them, and whose sins you retain, they are retained*” (Jn 20:23). Let us ask God our Father to open our hearts so that we may receive His Mercy in the form of the Holy Spirit Who abides in us from the moment of our Baptism.
