Weekly Reflection from Fr. Pau

When we face failures in life, the farmer in today's Gospel parable sounds a lot like many of us. We work hard, and only sometimes succeed.

We have to deal with failure, those areas where the best we've given to others comes up lacking, falling short of our hopes, our dreams, and our great expectations.

Jesus also knew well the pain of failure. He was rejected by hometown folks and by countrymen. Judas Iscariot sold Him out for thirty pieces of silver and the others fled when He was crucified.

Any crisis has within it both danger and opportunity. True there are evils that surround us, but many of those evils are slowly being overcome. God is at work among us bringing good out of evil.

We, like all farmers who continually face floods and disasters of every sort, need to seriously engage ourselves in the enterprise of faith and hope, planting the best of what we have, and then letting God's sun, wind, and gentle rains do the rest.

Parents taught their children the Catholic faith, sent them to religious education classes, or to Catholic schools just to see them as adults leave our Church and go elsewhere. However, the love and faith that we've planted in the hearts of those around us, particularly in the hearts and souls of our children, will eventually blossom. The hopes and dreams that we've planted in others, even when they seem to be buried under too much dirt, will grow and yield a harvest of some extent, even if our efforts do not now appear to be unqualified successes.

Our world is a mess now yet we can also see an amazing amount of goodness in it. We have our modern-day heroes among us who are leading us as never before in efforts to rid our world of oppression, racism, and injustice.

Let us keep on planting God's good seeds in the lives of our neighbors because for God Himself has said, "So shall my word be that goes forth from my mouth; It shall not return to me empty, but shall do what pleases me, achieving the end for which I sent it." (Is 55:11)

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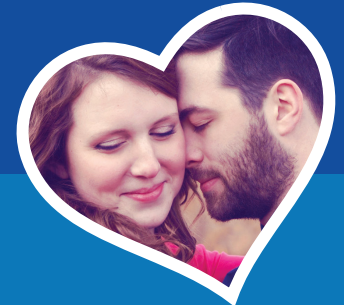
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
