Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

True renewal within our society will come about when we all can come to an agreement about who we are as human beings. Jesus Christ, the Son of God sent by the Heavenly Father, is the answer for the world. The apostles and disciples who witnessed this historic event of the life of Jesus Christ were given power from on high: the Holy Spirit! They waited patiently, obediently gathered together with Jesus' Mother, Mary. God created us in his image and likeness (see Genesis 1:27). Our human condition is fallen, that we are all sinners in need of help. God sent Jesus not only to help us but to renew us. None of us is any better than the other. We are in the same condition of being under the burden of sin. The Good News announced courageously by the apostles and disciples is the forgiveness of sins and renewal by the Holy Spirit. Jesus began his public ministry announcing: "This is the time of fulfillment. The kingdom of God is at hand. Repent, and believe in the gospel" (Mark 1:15).

While the world is filled with a variety of believers in different religions and those who have no religion, Jesus announces a "Good News" to the entire world, not just for the followers of Judaism. A new way of life is offered freely for those who admit the truth about sin, who then repent, and thus receive the gift of "the promise of the Father" (Acts 1:4). Recreated by God's love and mercy! Jesus did this for everyone and the apostles and disciples experienced this first-hand. The Holy Spirit moved them to live no longer in fear but in a "freedom" they did not know was possible previously. They spoke openly and with boldness about Jesus and the power of the love of God. Lives were being transformed as they announced Jesus and the power of the "name" alone brought healing, forgiveness, reconciliation, and truly "new life". God is among us! He has poured the Holy Spirit upon the world to bring us back to the state of life before the Fall. It is a gift given freely! Yes, Jesus' words are true: we are living in "the time of fulfillment", for "the kingdom of God is at hand". "For God so loved the world" – all of us! – "that he gave his only Son, so that everyone who believes in him might not perish but might have eternal life. For God did not send his Son into the world to condemn the world, but that the world might be saved through him" (John 3:16-17).

This renewal is offered daily, as the Spirit gives us life to love and serve one another. It is ongoing, as we tap into the source through the Church that Christ established through the apostles. Word and Sacrament sustain us and keep the flame of faith alive in our hearts, to be kept burning brightly until Jesus comes for us. This is why we need weekly Word and Sacrament as the "fuel", the oil replenished, to maintain the flame of the Holy Spirit burning within our hearts. Jesus said, "I have come to set the earth on fire, and how I wish it were already blazing" (Luke 12:49). The Holy Spirit is symbolized by the tongues of fire upon the apostles. These are flames that refine and purify our hearts, forming us in the ways of God, sin being the dross burnt away by God's grace. The seven gifts of the Holy Spirit create virtue which produces the twelve fruits of the Holy Spirit. Thank you, Heavenly Father, for bringing us back to You through Jesus and the wonderful outpouring of the Holy Spirit!

We thank Bishop John M. Quinn for his years of service to us here in the Diocese of Winona-Rochester as we await the arrival of his successor, Bishop Robert E. Barron, appointed on Thursday, June 2, 2022 by Pope Francis.
