Drivers can still use the circle drive to drop off passengers and the alley will be open.



A message from the desk of Father Marreddy

6th Sunday of Easter, May 25, 2025-C Acts 15:1-2,22-29, Revelation 21:10-14,22-23, John14:23-29

We come across three themes in today's Gospel reading: (1) love as the force that unites us to God; (2) the promise of the Holy Spirit; (3) the peace and joy that comes from Jesus' return to God.

Jesus said to His disciples: "This is my commandment: love one another as I love you. (John 15:12-17) "The person who has my commandments and keeps them or observes them, he or she is the one who loves me."

What we need to understand is that when Jesus spoke of love, it was not in terms of emotions. For Christ, love is primarily a matter of the will, attitude, and ACTION. The important thing about love is not what we feel, not what we say, but what we do. We show our love primarily by the things that we do. Love requires self-sacrifice. Love is self-giving. Jesus said that by our love for one another, people will know that we are His disciples.

Jesus left us with a special connection to Himself through the gift of the Holy Spirit. Jesus is alive is still present among us, within us, around us. We know Him through the Spirit of God in our deepest hearts... in our deepest being.

We live in the New Covenant of Jesus, daily facing uncertainty, conflict, and temptations. It is the abiding presence of God within us that enables us to face the future with undying hope and true Christian courage.

The gift of peace (shalom) that Jesus leaves with His disciples, has rich meaning in the Jewish community. It was used in greetings and partings, a wish for a life of harmony in God's community; a life lacking nothing; a life of complete fullness. The peace he gives us also stirs up in us a desire that such a peace be experienced by all and so the disciple is spurred to make this peace a reality in the world. Rather than being a source of contention or division, the disciple at home and in the marketplace works to create a healthy and life-sustaining harmony in the community. Well done!




