

A message from the desk of Father Marreddy

The Most Holy Trinity, June 15, 2025-C

Readings: Proverbs 8:22-31; Romans 5:1-5; John 16:12-15

Today we celebrate the Feast of the Holy Trinity. In our daily life we begin our prayers, activities, programs or works with the sign of the Cross and call upon God, "In the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit." Even though we remember the Trinity several times a day, it is difficult to comprehend the full meaning because the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit we invoke constitute a great Mystery. The Mystery of the Most Holy Trinity consists of this: the Father is God, the Son is God, and the Holy Spirit is God, and yet there are not three Gods, but only one God with three attributes. We have Father who is the Creator; Son, the Redeemer and Holy Spirit, the Sanctifier, and the Counselor. This is the Mystery of the Trinity of Persons in the One God. Jesus also tells us that He and the Father are one and He will send the Holy Spirit on the Apostles who will counsel and guide them in the mission.

How can we know God personally and grow in our understanding of His Wisdom, Truth, and Love for us? Jesus made a claim which only God can make: He knows all things - the present, the past and as well as the future. Jesus not only claims to speak the Truth, but He also calls Himself the very source of Truth when He proclaims that He is the Way, the Truth and the Life (John 14:6). Now Jesus promises to send His disciples the Spirit of Truth who will guide them in understanding all that Jesus came to say and do! Jesus tells His disciples that it is the role of the Holy Spirit to reveal what is true. It is through the gift and working of the Holy Spirit, who enlightens our hearts and minds that we come to understand that the Godhead is a Trinity of Persons - Father, Son, and Holy Spirit.

The Mission of Jesus and of the Holy Spirit is the same. This Mission is to reveal the glory of God and to share that glory with us by uniting us in a community of love with the Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. That is why Jesus tells His disciples that the Spirit will reveal the glory of the Father and the Son and will speak what is true.

Through the Holy Spirit, we proclaim our ancient faith in the saving death and resurrection of Jesus Christ until He comes again. The Lord gives us His Holy Spirit as our Divine Teacher and Helper that we may grow in the knowledge and wisdom of God.

Do we seek the wisdom that comes from above and do we eagerly listen to God's word and obey it?
