## CDA Education Contest 2023-24

The contest is open to all students from Grade 4-12. Hopefully all of your students will participate as the CDA will be awarding money for 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> place in each Division. First place is \$25, second is \$15 and third is \$10. The judging will be done by a teacher who is not a member of CDA or the church. The teacher will not be able to identify who has submitted the entry as the student will submit that information on the attached form and secured to the back side of their entry. I am sending out this one note and will attach a copy of the entrance form.

Here are the Divisions and which type of entries are acceptable for that grade division. Thanks for your on-going support of this program!!

Division 1	Grades 4-5	Essay, Poetry, Art, Computer Art
Division 2	Grades 6-7-8	Essay, Poetry, Art, Computer Art, Music, Photography

Division 3 Grades 9-10-11-12 Essay, Poetry, Art, Computer Art, Music, Photography

Contest theme can be either: "Gods love and kindness will shine upon us like the sun that rises in the sky. Luke 1:17 or How does my love shine for others?

RULES: All entries must be of contestant's own imagination and creations.

Essay: Typed only, not to exceed 450 words on one page; not front and back.

Poetry: Any style of poetry, typed, not to exceed eight (8) lines.

Art: <u>Size:</u> 8 ½ x 11 <u>No lettering</u> (your art carries the message). **Do not put you name on the Art**. How the theme is carried out in Art will be part of the judging, in addition to artistic talent. <u>Medium:</u> Crayon, markers, ink, paints (water color, acrylic, oil), charcoal, pencil (black or colored), pastels (chalk) and duct tape.

Computer Art: Size:  $8 \% \times 11$  or  $8'' \times 12''$ , No lettering. Art must be artists' own creation and should fill the majority of the page. NO clip art or images imported from websites.

Music: Lyrics and notes must be on professional music score paper (melody, harmony and accompaniment, all of which must be notated accurately), and must be contestant's own creation. Please use composition music paper with composer's name. CD, thumb drive (no Mp3, MIDI, or other electronic formats allowed) of the performance must accompany the entry using music score paper and

name on it. While the composition must be the contestant's own creation, the performer of the composition does not need to be the composer. No DVD.

**Photography:** Size 8" x 10" picture depicting the theme. Do not add matting. The contestant must have taken picture. May not be a computer downloaded image or a picture of a picture. Can be color or black and white. Cannot be a collage. . **Cannot be a copy of a photography as it needs to be the photograph.** 

Judges will use rules of Clarity, Grammar, Spelling, Interpretation of Theme and all peculiar rules in the categories listed above

## **GENERAL RULES**

- 1) Contestants may enter a Category only once but may submit entries in multiple categories. A local Catholic Daughters Court must sponsor contestants..
- 2) Entries on other themes or not conforming to the rules will be disqualified.
- Entries will not be returned. All contest material becomes the property of the National Court with the right to display/ and or publish any or all material.
- 4) Decisions of the judges will be final. Judges reserve the right to make no award in a Division or Category. Commercial entries will be disqualified. Judging will be based on the Rubric scoring provided.
- 5) Each 2023-2024 Entry Form must accompany each entry <u>properly signed and completed</u>. Names must be legible. Forms are to be glued or taped to the back of the entry, except for music. Music entry forms to be put in plastic sleeve and CD or thumb drive with it.

## DEADLINE TO BE RECEIVED BY MARY ZABEL BY FEBRUARY 1ST.

If a contestant wins  $\mathbf{1}^{\text{st}}$  in  $\mathbf{2}$  themes, only one can be submitted to state.

Local awards: 1st Place \$25, second\$15 and 3rd \$10.

Please note that any entries are NOT to be folded. All religious Education entries shall be given to Jenna by the January 31<sup>st</sup> deadline and she will forward them to Mary Zabel.
