

2023 CATHOLIC SERVICE APPEAL REPORT

Our Parish Goal is \$25,934. As of May 18, 2023 we have pledged \$7,595. We have 36 families participating for 16%. The percent of our goal pledged is 29.3% and \$5,880 has been contributed. We have approximately 230 families in our parish.
