Dear Sacred Heart.

Bishop Robert Barron did a Catholic Church Survey of pew Catholics attending Mass which asked if they believed in the true presence of God in the Eucharist. Bishop Barron found that only 35% attending Mass did believe in the real presence. What a loss this is to not believe God's love for them is truly present in real time. Do they think that our Creator is limited? Can he be physically present to us?

To address this concern, Fr. Mark has found a Little Rock Scripture Study, <u>The Eucharist in Scripture</u>, a 5-week program perfect for lent. We have purchased Little Rock booklets with a video to walk us through this <u>program</u>. Fr. Mark will start this program this coming Sunday, February 25th at 9:00 am in the Chapel in the Rectory. This is an excellent opportunity for parents with children in the parish school of religion and for the entire church family.
