



Reflection on the Trinity

Recently on the Vatican website was the following reflection on the Trinity:

"Today's feast invites us to live in the awareness of the presence of the Triune God within us: The Father, the Son and the Holy Spirit. The mystery of the Holy Trinity, a doctrine enunciated by the ecumenical councils of Nicaea and Constantinople, is one of the fundamental doctrines of Christianity and the greatest mystery of our Faith, namely, that there are Three Divine Persons, sharing the same Divine nature in one God. "There is one God, who has three Persons, Father, Son and Holy Spirit. Each Person is God, yet there is still only one God" (CCC #234, #253-256). We have Father Who is the Creator, Son, the Redeemer and Holy Spirit, the Sanctifier and the Counselor. The doctrine of Three Persons in one God, equal in Divinity yet distinct in Person, is not explicitly spelt out in the Bible. Even the very word "Trinity" is not found in the Bible. But the doctrine of the Trinity underlies all major Christian feasts, including Christmas, the Epiphany, Good Friday, Easter, the Ascension and Pentecost. All the official prayers of the Church, including the Holy Mass and the Sacraments, begin with an address to the Holy Trinity: "In the Name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit." We are baptized, absolved of our sins and anointed in the name of the Blessed Trinity...We bless ourselves with the Sign of the Cross invoking the Name of the Father, Son and Holy Spirit and we conclude our prayers glorifying the Holy Trinity, saying "Glory be to the Father and to the Son and to the Holy Spirit." Today's readings convey the fundamental mystery that the Triune God reaches out to people in love, seeking the deepest communion with them."

The Trinity may be a mystery, but the love that flows within the three persons of God and thus to each one of us is not a mystery. It is very real and we are so blessed to be able to share in that reality each moment of every day.

Graduations

Over the next two weeks, Lisa and I are involved in the graduation celebrations of our parish elementary schools and secondary school. It is exciting this year that we are able to be part of these celebrations in person, rather than virtually. Please keep these students in your prayers as they complete this important milestone in their lives and as they prepare for the next part of their journey.

Reminder about Offertory Gifts

Another ministry that we are starting up again is "Offertory Gift Bearers". This ministry involves bringing the gifts of bread and wine and the Sunday collection from the back of the church to the altar. If you are interested in volunteering, please contact Kim. Since we are bringing forward the Sunday collection, we are encouraging you to place your donation in the basket as you enter the church (rather than placing it in the basket as you exit the church). Bringing forward the collection represents the financial offering of those present to assist in the operation of the church and to minister to those in need, so we would prefer that everyone's contribution is being brought forward at that time. If you are not comfortable in doing so, the baskets will still be available at the end of Mass at the main entrance.

Reminder about Gift Cards

We have started selling Gift Cards before/after Mass again at St. John the Baptist. We have also started taking order forms for Gift Cards at St. Anthony of Padua. As always, Gift Cards can be purchased during the week during normal office hours. Any cheques for the purchases should be made out to the parish that you are registered in. This past week we sold nearly \$9,000.00 in cards making a profit of over \$200. That may not seem like much, but if we were to do that every week, we would bring in over \$10,000.00 extra annually for ministries or capital expenses!

The gift cards are an excellent way to raise money for the church without "costing" you any extra money. When you purchase a gift card you get the full value of the card to be spent at that place of business, i.e you pay \$100 for a grocery card and you get to spend \$100. The company we get the cards from gives us a percentage of the sale. So every card you buy, in a sense gives the church "free" money – we get a percentage of the sale and it does not cost you any extra. If you have any questions, please contact Karen (519-736-5418).
