Sunday Reflection

On the 8th Sunday in Ordinary Time Year C, we reflect on the power of our words. Sirach 27:4-7 teaches that our words reveal who we really are. Good words show a good heart, while bad words reveal inner

problems. Our speech can lift others up or tear them down. Luke 6:43-45 also talks about the connection between our hearts and actions. Jesus compares people to trees, saying that good trees bear good fruit. This means our actions and words reflect our inner goodness. If our hearts are good, we will naturally do and say good things.



We need to be careful with our words. Speaking kindly and truthfully can show our faith and love for others. Harsh or dishonest words can hurt people and damage our witness as Christians. Reflecting on how we speak helps us grow in holiness.

Our words also impact our relationships. Kind words can build strong friendships and trust. Hurtful words can create distance and conflict. By watching what we say, we can strengthen our bonds with others and show them Christ's love. Our words are a window to our hearts. Let us strive to speak words that reflect our faith and love for God and others.

Ash Wednesday

This Wednesday we begin Lent. We will be having two Masses for Ash Wednesday - 9:00am at St. John the Baptist and 7:00pm at St. Anthony of Padua. As well, we will be having Liturgy of the Word Services at Stella Maris and St. Anthony for our students.



Fasting and Abstinence



Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are obligatory days of fasting and abstinence for Catholics. In addition, Fridays during Lent are obligatory days of abstinence. For members of the Latin Catholic Church, the norms on fasting are obligatory from age 18 until age 59. When fasting, a person is permitted to eat one full meal. Two smaller meals may also be taken, but not to equal a full meal.

The norms concerning abstinence from meat are binding upon members of the Latin Catholic Church from age 14 onwards. Drinking water, tea, juices, etc. do not constitute breaking the fast. As well, people are encouraged to take their normal medications.

Stations of the Cross

Beginning Friday, March 7th at 7:00pm we will be celebrating the Stations of the Cross. Each week they will be led by a different group from our Family of Parishes. We will alternate between the two parish churches – at St. Anthony of Padua on March 7, March 21, April 4; at St. John the Baptist March 14, 28, April 11. Please join us for this meaningful devotion of walking the final steps of Jesus during this Lenten Season.

Outreach Committee and Lenten Pilgrimage Historical Church Tour

Building upon my reflections about our future direction as a Family of Parishes, over the last few months we have been working on establishing an Outreach committee. This committee will reach out to our parishioners as a sign of welcome and provide us with opportunities to get to know one another and our faith better. Their first initiative gives us a chance to discover, through a spirit of prayer and fellowship, more about the rich history of some of the parishes in our area.
