

Sunday Reflection



"Supposing him to be the gardener, she [Mary Magdalene] said to him, 'Sir if you have carried him away, tell me where you have laid him, and I will take him away." Mary is a wonderful example of what is means to be a disciple of Jesus. Firstly, she was looking for Jesus. Finding Jesus is so important for our journey of faith. Without Jesus we are lost. She reminds us that we need to be seeking Jesus at all times. Where do we find him? We find him in those around

us – our families, our friends, our co-workers, even the stranger on the street. We find him in the beauty and wonder of creation. We find him in our prayer and in the regular reception of the sacraments, especially the Eucharist. We find him in scripture (in particular by reading the Gospels) and in the writings of saints and spiritual authors.

After encountering Jesus what did Mary do? She ran to tell the apostles...to spread the Good News. We too need to go forth and proclaim the resurrected Christ. Our words and actions should reveal Jesus to those around us. Even though we may not fulfill that mission well all the time (for that is what sin is), we still strive for that goal. We need to show love and kindness to the special people in our lives that God has blessed us with and not take them for granted (spouses, children, parents, brothers and sisters, etc.). We need to use language that builds people up and not be judgmental or critical. We need to reach out to the poor and those who are struggling in any way. We need to be people of joy and hope (especially during this Jubilee Year as Pilgrims of Hope).

We are so blessed in our Family of Parishes. My thanks to all who joined us this Easter. On behalf of our Pastoral Team and Staff, may you and your families know and experience the joy and wonder of the resurrection in your hearts each and every day!



Divine Mercy Sunday

Next Sunday is Divine Mercy Sunday. We have a very merciful God who wants to share with us his gift of mercy/forgiveness. As Jesus said to St. Faustina, "I want to grant a complete pardon to the souls that will go to Confession and receive Holy Communion on the Feast of My Mercy". The Feast of Divine Mercy is celebrated on the Second Sunday of Easter which concludes the Octave of Easter. This Feast is based upon the devotion to Divine Mercy that St. Faustina Kowalska (a Polish nun and saint) reported as part of her encounter with Jesus, and is associated with special promises from Jesus and plenary indulgences declared by the Church. Our Family of Parishes will be celebrating the Divine Mercy Sunday Prayer Service at St. John the Baptist, April 27th at 3:00pm. Confessions will be available beginning at 2:00pm.


