

Sunday Reflection

Jesus' ascension gives us hope that we will be with Him in heaven. The second reading from Hebrews talks about Jesus entering heaven to appear before God for us. This is a promise that we, too, can share in this eternal life.



The Ascension of the Lord reminds us that Jesus completed His mission on earth and now prepares a place for us with God. This event shows us that our true home is in heaven. We are called to live in a way that reflects this hope and prepares us for eternal life with Him.

Knowing that Jesus is in heaven, interceding for us, gives us confidence in our faith. The second reading from Hebrews encourages us to approach God with trust and sincerity, knowing Jesus is there for us. This motivates us to live according to His teachings and strive to be close to Him.

The Ascension of the Lord is a time to reflect on our own journey to heaven. It inspires us to stay faithful and share this hope with others. We are reminded that our mission is to spread the Good News and live as witnesses to Jesus' love and promises. Now, His power works through us. We must carry on the mission of proclaiming the Good News to the world.






