## VOTIVE STANDS

In 2009 an electronic votive light stand was purchased for St. John the Baptist Church by the Historical Committee and a second was added in 2011. These are located under the statue of Mary at the front of the church and the Divine Mercy at the back. To light a candle, a donation of \$2 is suggested.

To light a perpetual candle and have it dedicated, please contact the parish office or call one of the committee members, Bonnie Deslippe at 519-996-4085 or Anne St. Louis at 519-736-0731. The cost is \$200/annually or \$100/6 months.

In the past, the funds from these votive stands have been used to make a significant donation to the restoration of the steeple, to purchase altar linens, to the upholstery of the sanctuary chairs and piano cover. A significant donation was made to the accessibility entrance, the rebuild of the rectory porch and the purchase of a granite St. John the Baptist that is installed on a limestone rock in front of the rectory and the lighting of it. Over the years, the donations have also been given to the pastor to decide where they can best be used. Future funds will be used in other heritage projects that will be addressed by the parish.

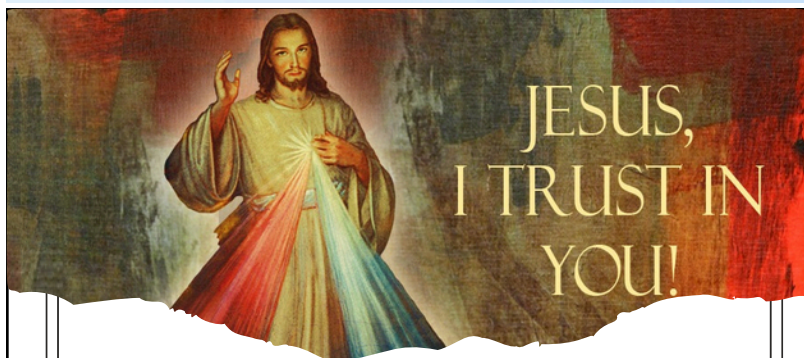
