



Google "BOOST scholarship 2025 Maryland" to be linked to the page to begin the process. The scholarship is income-based and a chart is available to see if you qualify.

The Father Hughes Scholarship application is currently open. Applicants must be parishioners of St. Matthias and have a financial aid application on file in TADS.com. **The deadline for both BOOST and Father Hughes is May 9, 2025.** Applications for the Father Hughes scholarship may be dropped off at the school or parish office.
