Mass Guidelines During Covid-19

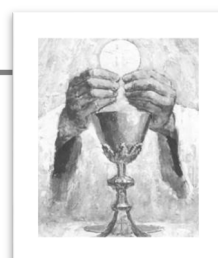
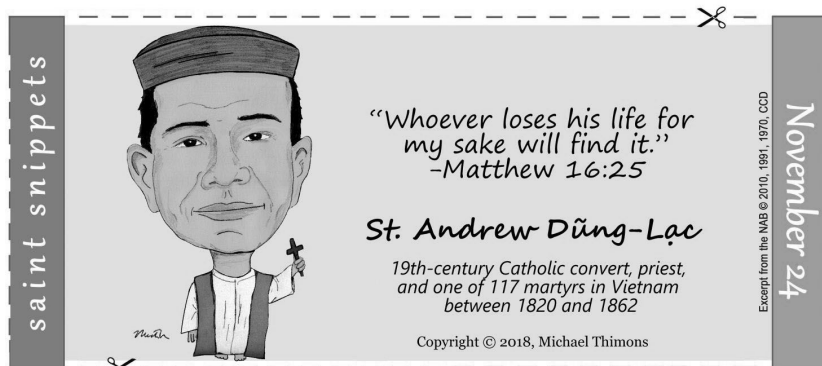
***Please remember, at this time NO ONE is yet obligated to attend Mass.**

If you do attend Mass, please note our current guidelines:

1. Masks are required (per Fargo's Amended Executive Order from Nov. 16).
2. To maintain appropriate physical distancing, we are only using every other pew. The ones to keep vacant are marked.
3. We are still required to omit the Exchange of Peace and the Offertory Procession, so we will keep an offertory box at the back of the Church and the Main Entrance for you to place your offering in.
4. We will continue to livestream the 9:00 AM Sunday Mass via Facebook and also have past Masses available on our St. Anthony's YouTube Channel.
5. We will distribute communion in the parking lot at the 9:00 AM Sunday Mass only.

His encyclical reminds the faithful that while governments and philosophies come and go, Christ reigns as king forever.

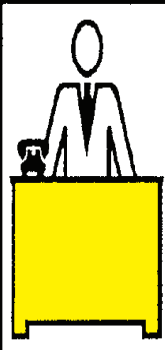
