
















## Our Opportunities in 2022 - 2023

- Reengage parishioners to come back to in-person Mass, enhancing participation in the Eucharist, refreshing old friendships and make new ones.
- Reignite the Good Shepherd active and welcoming community with in-person gatherings that engage volunteers and build fellowship ties.
- Rebuild religious formation for our public school students in K-8, junior and high school programs. A full time staff person was recently hired to grow interest among our families whose options were limited during COVID.
- Reinvest in our students. Our school is recognized as a School of Excellence by the State of Kansas and one of the top academic elementary schools in the archdiocese. Our new Innovation Hub opens this year to provide digital based technologies to give our students state of the art learning opportunities in critical thinking, peer collaboration and hands-on-learning experiences.
- Reinvest in our staff. The staff will receive a 4% raise in 2022-23 as decided by the Johnson County Regional Priests, partially making up for a year with no raises.
