

The Catechism of the Catholic Church

Paragraphs 131 - 133

Sacred Scripture in the Life of the Church

131 "and such is the force and power of the Word of God that it can serve the Church as her support and vigour, and the children of the Church as strength for their faith, food for the soul, and a pure and lasting fount of spiritual life." Hence "access to Sacred Scripture ought to be open wide to the Christian faithful."

132 "Therefore, the study of the sacred page should be the very soul of sacred theology. the ministry of the Word, too - pastoral preaching, catechetics and all forms of Christian instruction, among which the liturgical homily should hold pride of place - is healthily nourished and thrives in holiness through the Word of Scripture."

133 The Church "forcefully and specifically exhorts all the Christian faithful... to learn the surpassing knowledge of Jesus Christ, by frequent reading of the divine Scriptures. Ignorance of the Scriptures is ignorance of Christ.



A Letter from Fr. Christian

Dear friends,

I'd like to take a few moments to speak about Mass offerings. I'm referring to when a parishioner comes into the office and requests a Mass intention to be offered on a selected date. The suggested offering for a Mass to be said for a specific intention is \$10.00. This is a standard around the country. It's important to be aware that when we make an offering for Mass to be said we are not "buying a Mass." Sometimes I've heard people make the comment that, "this is my Mass because I bought it." This is not possible. The Mass is Christ's Mass, it is for all of us, and cannot be bought at any price. The Mass offering is paying for the service the priest provides, for his time and efforts, and the cost of bread and wine. It is the policy of the diocese of Kansas City - St. Joseph for Mass offerings to be placed into the regular parish income after the Mass has been offered. For now I just want to emphasize that the term "I would like to make a Mass offering" is best used when requesting a Mass to be said rather than, "I would like to buy a Mass." I will speak more on this subject next week.






