

Catholic schools. The monies collected are placed in a common fund that assists families who send their children to Catholic schools. We appreciate your financial support of this collection!





Why is it important to be registered at a parish?

When someone is asked to be a godparent at Baptism or a sponsor for Confirmation, that person must provide verification that he/she is a member "in good standing" of our parish. There have been times that we were unable to provide a sponsor letter because an individual was not registered. Merely attending Mass is not sufficient

documentation that you are a parishioner, nor is saying that your parents are registered. If you are an adult (over 18 years of age) you need to register on your own. Registering is easy. You can find forms in the back of the church, at the parish office, or on our website www.ollakes.org.


