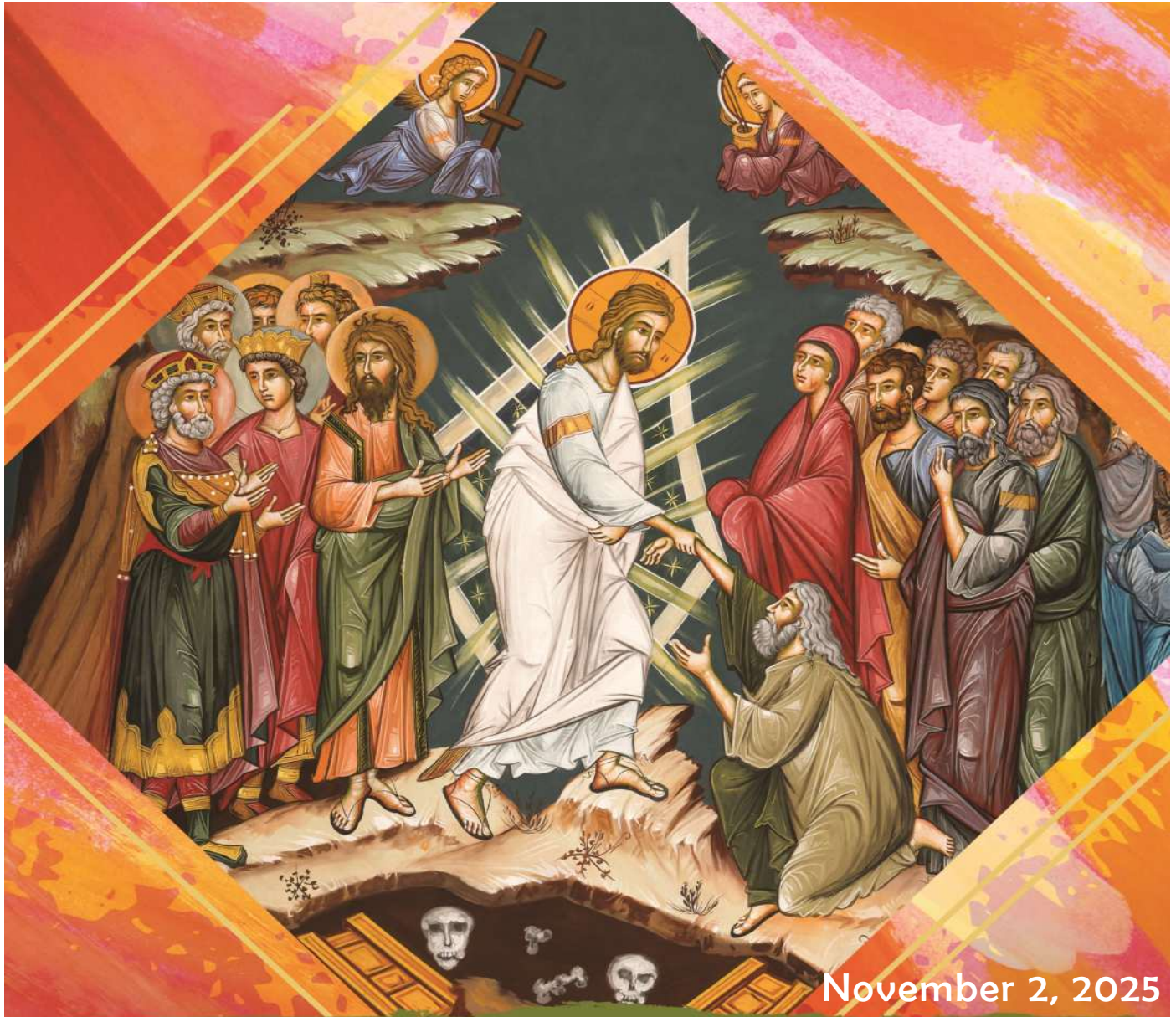

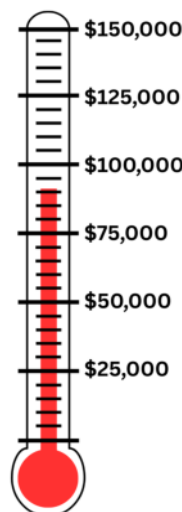

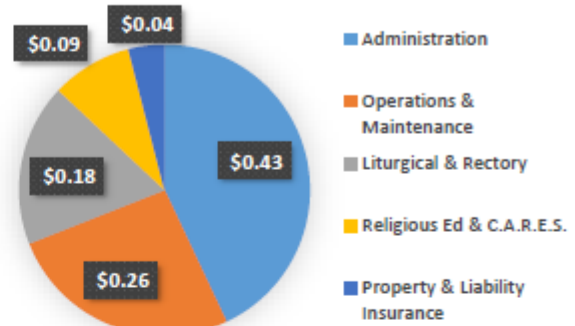

- > Administration Expense includes the Diocesan Management Expense (previously stated as a separate line item) which accounts for 28% (19,809) of the total expense of \$70,349
- > Religious Ed & C.A.R.E.S includes the 'Elementary Education Subsidy' (previously stated as a separate line item) which accounts for 72% (\$11,239) of the total expense of \$15,600
- > Extraordinary Maintenance Expense includes work done to stabilize the rectory at the Transfiguration campus and to continue the parking lot rehabilitation project *

*\$71,354 is included in the Extraordinary Maintenance Expense to cover the completion of the TRC parking lot, and to begin the work at the STV campus. We have used funds from various sources to continue moving the project forward in hopes of the Capital Campaign replenishing these funds
