Did You Know? ¿Sabías Que?

WHAT TO DO IF A CHILD DISCLOSES ABUSE QUÉ HACER SI UN NIÑO TE REVELA QUE HA SIDO ABUSADO

If a child tells you about sexual abuse, the first and most important step to take is to listen to him or her. Let the child fully express the situation and how he or she is feeling. It's important to be aware that children may not always disclose abuse in clear terms. Let the child know that you are listening, and that you believe him or her. Remind him or her of how brave it is to disclose this, and that you will help. Report any suspicion of abuse to authorities. Saber distinguir entre la conducta apropiado para la edad de los niños y lo inapropiado puede ayudar a los adultos de confianza a determinar si hay algo "raro" en el comportamiento de un niño y que podría indicar posible abuso sexual. Para los niños de edad preescolar y los más pequeños (entre 4-6 años), explorar su cuerpo es algo natural. Naturalmente, no tienen edad para entender la idea de "lo privado" y también pueden sentir curiosidad por los cuerpos de los demás: padres, amigos, etc. Estos comportamientos son comunes y apropiados para su edad y etapa de desarrollo. 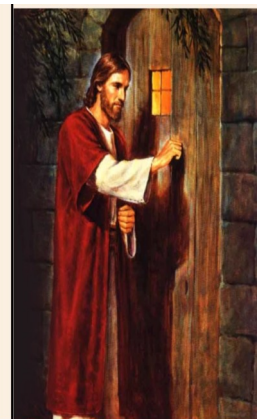

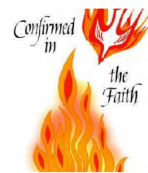

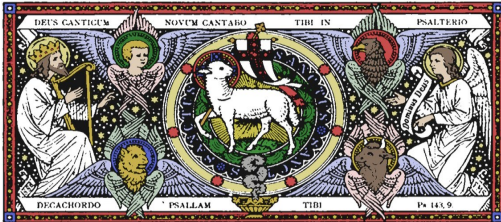


The Sheep and the Shepherd

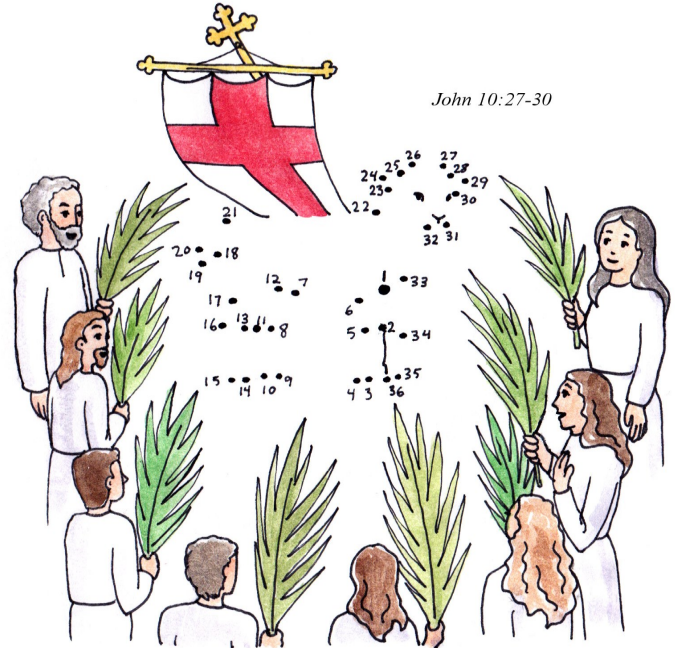
Answer to Word Puzzle: GOOD SHEPHERD
