SUMMER AND WATER SAFETY AT HOME VERANO Y SEGURIDAD EN EL AGUA EN CASA

While parents are often hyper vigilant around pools and lakes, drowning can happen at home in an instant, especially with very young children. This summer, watch children around water at home, including buckets, containers, and kiddie pools. Children can drown in as little as an inch of water, so constant supervision is necessary. 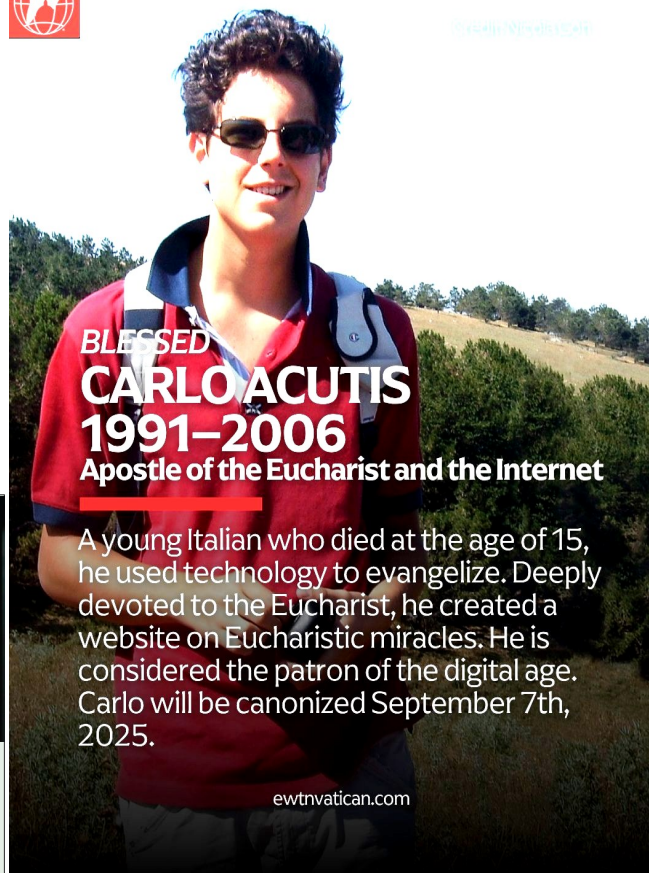

FEAST DAY / SOLEMNIDAD: JUNE 29 / 29 DE JUNIO

Today, as we celebrate the Feast of Saints Peter and Paul, we are invited to reflect on two incredible lives—and how their journey speaks to ours.

Hoy, al celebrar la solemnidad de San Pedro y San Pablo, se nos invita a reflexionar sobre dos vidas extraordinarias y cómo su camino habla a nuestras propias vidas.

Saint Peter was a fisherman—passionate, impulsive, and very human. He walked on water, proclaimed Jesus as the Messiah... and then denied Him three times. Yet Christ did not give up on Peter. He called him the rock upon which He would build His Church.

San Pedro era pescador: apasionado, impulsivo y muy humano. Caminó sobre el agua, proclamó a Jesús como el Mesías... y luego lo negó tres veces. Sin embargo, Cristo no se dio por vencido con Pedro. Lo llamó la roca sobre la cual edificaría Su Iglesia.

How many times have we stumbled in faith, doubted, or fallen short? And yet, like Peter, we are still called, still loved, still trusted by God to do great things.

¿Cuántas veces hemos tropezado en la fe, dudado o fallado? Y aun así, como Pedro, seguimos siendo llamados, seguimos siendo amados y Dios sigue confiando en nosotros para hacer grandes cosas.

Saint Paul was once Saul, a persecutor of Christians. But one encounter with the risen Christ changed everything. He became a tireless missionary, spreading the Gospel to the ends of the known world.

San Pablo fue antes Saulo, un perseguidor de cristianos. Pero un encuentro con el Cristo resucitado lo cambió todo. Se convirtió en un misionero incansable, llevando el Evangelio hasta los confines del mundo conocido.

How many of us carry regret, or think we're disqualified from doing God's work because of our past? Paul's life shows us that no story is beyond redemption—and that our greatest failures can become the very place where God's light shines through.

¿Cuántos de nosotros cargamos con remordimientos o pensamos que nuestro pasado nos descalifica para hacer la obra de Dios? La vida de Pablo nos muestra que ninguna historia está más allá de la redención y que nuestros mayores fracasos pueden ser el lugar donde brille la luz de Dios.

Today we ask ourselves: What part of Peter or Paul lives in me? Where is God calling me to be a disciple—in my family, my parish, my community?

Hoy nos preguntamos: ¿Qué parte de Pedro o Pablo vive en mí? ¿A dónde me está llamando Dios a ser discípulo—en mi familia, mi parroquia, mi comunidad?

Saints Peter and Paul were not perfect—but they were faithful. And through them, the Church was built. May we, too, have the courage to say “yes” to the mission Christ has for each of us.

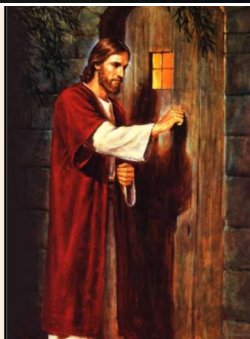

Peter and Paul



Today we are celebrating the feast of Saints Peter and Paul. They are such important saints that their feast day takes the place of the usual Sunday. Saint Peter was the chief of the Apostles.

He was close to Our Lord, and the only one that Jesus told, "you are Peter (which means rock) and on this rock I will build my Church..." Saint Peter had a hard time accepting that Jesus had to die, and he also denied Jesus. But he was sorry afterward and became a strong leader for the disciples after Jesus went back into Heaven. Saint Peter was the Church's first pope.

Saint Paul was a Jew who at first was against the Christians. He even helped to persecute them. But then Jesus appeared to him and Paul became a Christian and a great preacher. His mission was to preach to the Gentiles, the people who didn't know about God or His promises. He wrote many letters that are now part of the Bible.

Both Saint Peter and Saint Paul preached and taught about Jesus and brought the Faith to many people and places. But the Roman government did not like the Christians. The emperor Nero began killing the Christians, and among those killed were Peter and Paul. Their deaths didn't stop the Church from growing, though. When people die for God it brings even more grace into the Church.

Today we should thank God for sending us these great saints, and we can also pray that we will help to spread the Faith.
